Notes: This marks the 20th all-time match up between the Hokies and 'Hoos ... Tech fell at Virginia last season, 10-5, but claimed its only win in the series at home in 2012, topping the No. 7 Cavaliers 10-9 in overtime ... The two schools have met once in the post season, and Virginia has been ranked in all but three all-time meetings.

Scouting Virginia

Virginia enters its final conference game of the season with an 8-7 record on the year, sitting at 2-4 in league play. The Cavaliers recently ended a four-game winning streak over the weekend, falling 13-8 at No. 2 Maryland. Prior to the loss, Virginia logged a pair of top-10 ACC victories in its winning streak as it knocked off Notre Dame on the road and Boston College at home.

Courtney Swan leads the 'Hoos this season with 41 goals and 18 assists on the year. Liza Blue isn't far behind with 41 goals, while also winning 40 draws.

Lauren Goerz has helped pace the defensive efforts, causing 14 turnovers and grabbing 26 ground balls this year. Liz Colgan has been a mainstay in goal for Virginia this season and has made 150 saves on the year, also boasting a .462 save percentage and the team's record.

Hokie Notes

-- Junior Meg Bartley set a new career and team season high against Liberty, scoring six goals in the win.

-- Junior Megan Will broke onto Tech's all-time scoring list with four goals against Coastal Carolina and the points list with three goals at No. 1 North Carolina. She scored the 100th goal of her career at Old Dominion.

-- Junior Cawley Bromley had a career game at William & Mary, scoring three goals and finishing with four points and made it back-to-back four-point games against Coastal.

-- Against No. 6 Duke, the Hokie defense forced the Blue Devils into a season-high 18 turnovers with their average of 10 coming in the first half, also holding them to a season-low four first-half goals.

-- Entering the week, two Hokies rank among the top 30 in the nation in their respective categories. Junior Meg Bartley ranks the highest of the group, sitting at 13th in the country averaging 5.14 draws per game.

-- Redshirt senior Julia Heaps set a career high with five goals and seven points in the season opener at James Madison.

-- Redshirt senior Julia Heaps became the second Hokie on the 2014 roster to rank among the all-time best as her three assists against High Point broke her onto the list.

-- In this week's polls, seven of Tech's opponents are ranked nationally, with another receiving votes.

-- Seniors Julia Heaps, Kelly Naslonski, Lindsay Roche and Becca Niles captain the Hokies this season.

-- Tech welcomed 10 freshmen this season, as well as two new assistant coaches.

The Nation's Elite

Entering the week of play, two Hokies rank among the top players in the nation in their respective categories. Junior Meg Bartley boasts the highest ranking, as she's 13th with a 5.14 draws average. Junior Megan Will is 23rd in the country with 56 points this year, while also ranking 28th with 4.00 points per game and 23rd with 39 goals.

Virginia is also represented in the top 30 by two players this week as Courtney Swan ranks in the top 13 in the country in points, draws per game and goals. Goalie Liz Colgan is second in the nation with 150 saves and sixth with 10.00 saves per game.

Against The Best

Being in the Atlantic Coast Conference, the Hokies play a number of the nation's best teams and players on a weekly basis. Tech has already faced five ranked opponents this season after traveling to No. 6 Boston College over the weekend. All seven of Tech's conference opponents rank in the top 20 in both polls with six of them ranking in the top 10.

Although Tech is just 5-79 against ranked opponents, the Hokies have knocked off two ranked opponents in two of the last three seasons.

Record Watch

Junior Meg Bartley has already broken into the all-time top 10, and is tied for second with 184 career draws. She has also made her second notch on the single-seasons draw list, ranking second with 69 last year. She is on pace this season to set a new all-time single season record.

Redshirt senior Julia Heaps broke into the all-time assists list against High Point earlier this year. She currently ranks sixth all-time with 43.

Junior Megan Will's 42 goals last season landed her on the single-season scoring list, ranking seventh. She broke into the all-time career scoring list against Coastal Carolina and is currently 7th all-time with 111 career goals and 147 career points. Will needs just one assist to crack the top-10.

Scoring at Will

Junior Megan Will has scored in 12 of 14 games for the Hokies so far this year. The Bel Air, Md., native neared a career high at Longwood, after setting the mark against the Lancers a year ago, when she put away five goals and assisted two more. Will matched that season-best mark when she scored five goals against Liberty.

At Old Dominion, Will continued to climb Tech's all-time scoring list while also putting away the 100th goal of her career.

Bartley, an Unexpected Surprise

Junior Meg Bartley walked on to the Tech lacrosse team in the Fall of 2011 and as the 2012 season began she made a quick and efficient impact. The Lewes, Del., native earned a starting job on attack by the fifth game, after scoring four goals and assisting another against UC Davis at home. Bartley finally surpassed the career scoring mark with six goals against Liberty.

Bartley has been a huge threat for the Hokies on the draw. After leading the league in the category a season ago, she sits at second in the ACC and is 13th in the nation, averaging 5.14.

Seasoned Sophomores

With a year of on-field experience under their belts, sophomores Meghan Macera and Jessi Thon have become consistent leaders in the midfield. The pair has combined for 38 points and round out the top three on the team in draws this year. Macera is third in the ACC averaging 2.50 ground balls per game, while Thon is third with 1.29 caused turnovers per game.

Veteran Advantage

Redshirt senior Julia Heaps got her final season as a Hokie off to an impressive start at James Madison. Heaps has a career day, setting new highs in goals (5) and points (7).

In the home opener against High Point, Heaps made her way onto Tech's all-time assists list with three in the game. The Street, Md., native is currently ranked sixth all-time with 43 career assists.

Consistent Contribution

Junior Jack Boissonneault has earned a starting spot in the midfield this season and has quietly been a consistent contributor for Tech all year. Boissonneault has had at least one point in nine of Tech's 14 games. Despite seeing the majority of her minutes on the defensive end, the Brooklin, Ontario, Canada native takes advantage of her time on offense and has scored in each of the last four games.

Graham in Goal

Freshman goalie Meagh Graham has been an aggressive threat on defense and a stronghold in cage for the Hokies early in her career. Starting every game of the season, Graham is second on the team in ground balls (33) and recently set a new career high with 13 saves against No. 3 Syracuse.

Protecting the Cage

Tech's starting defensive unit of Lindsay Roche, Becca Niles, Kelsey Allen and Maddy Hess is newly assembled this season and entered the year with just two starts among them. This year the

quartet has combined for 52 ground balls and 23 caused turnovers through eight games and recently notched arguably it's best performance of the year against No. 6 Duke. With the help of goalie Meagh Graham, who adds 33 ground balls and 13 caused turnovers of her own, the Hokies held Duke to a season-low four first-half goals and forced the Blue Devils into a season-high 18 turnovers in the game.
