LAST TIME OUT

The Hokies headed north for Spring Break this year and came home 1-1 on the week. Tech picked up a big overtime win at Michigan on Wednesday night, before falling No. 17 Notre Dame Saturday afternoon.

The overtime win was a huge night for senior Meg Bartley as she broke the all-time draw controls record at Tech when she won the first draw of the second session of overtime. As if the record wasn't big enough, it was Bartley that put away the game-winner with .2 second remaining in overtime.

Tech went down 6-1 to open the game, but battled back to take a 7-6 lead into the halftime break. Play went back and forth for much of the second half. It looked like Tech was going to take the late lead in regulation but the goal was called back for an illegal stick. Michigan was able to capitalize less than a minute later, but the late heroics of Megan Will with 26.6 on the clock kept the Hokies alive and forced overtime.

HOKIES IN OVERTIME

Tech is 5-1 all-time in overtime games following the victory at Michigan. The Hokies are 2-0 in overtime under Head Coach Megan Burkner, with the other win coming in 2012 when Tech knocked off then-No. 7 Virginia at home.

IT'S HERS TO SET

Meg Bartley became Tech's all-time career draw controls leader after winning the opening draw of the second session of overtime in Tech's win at Michigan. Bartley finished the game with six draws, and currently has 247 in her career. The Lewes, Delaware, native also holds the single-season record after propelling herself to 90 with a career-high 10 in the final game of the 2014 season.

RECORD WATCH

Megan Will is quickly climbing the all-time charts at Tech, chasing her cousin, Dawn Will, who sits atop the career goals and points lists. Megan currently ranks second with 153 career goals and 197 career points. She is also seventh all-time at Tech with 44 career assists.

Will is one of just three players to rank among the

all-time top 10 in all three offensive categories (Allie Emala 08-11, Catherine Augustyn 96-99).

Meghan Macera recently joined Meg Bartley on the all-time draws list, as she has won 113 so far, good for seventh.

SCORING AT WILL

Senior Megan Will is currently in the midst of a 14-game scoring streak that dates back to last season. The Bel Air, Maryland, native enters the weekend as the ACC's leading scorer (33) and the points (41) leader.

Will has scored at least three goals in 12 of the last 14 games, as she climbs all three all-time offensive stat lists at Tech.

BARTLEY, AN UNEXPECTED SURPRISE

Senior Meg Bartley walked on to the Tech lacrosse team in the fall of 2011 and as the 2012 season began she made a quick and efficient impact. The Lewes, Delaware, native earned a starting job on attack by the fifth game, after scoring four goals and assisting another against UC Davis at home and has been a staple in the lineup ever since.

LIMITING THE OPPONENT

The Hokies neared the first shutout in program history as they held Gardner-Webb scoreless until there was under four minutes remaining in the game. Tech eventually won the game 20-1, marking just the second game ever that the Hokies have held their opponent to a single goal (at St. Bonaventure, 4/23/00).

AGAINST THE BEST

Being in the Atlantic Coast Conference, the Hokies play a number of the nation's best teams and players on a weekly basis. Tech's schedule includes nine teams that are currently ranked in the top 20. The Hokies began Spring Break traveling to No. 5 Duke, and facing No. 17 Notre Dame. This week Tech hosts No. 10 Louisville.
