LAST TIME OUT

The Hokies gave top-seeded North Carolina a battle in the first round of the ACC Tournament, but eventually fell, 18-12. Hat tricks by Meg Bartley and Megan Will paced the offense for the Hokies, and also helped Will become the all-time career points leader at Tech. Bartley and Will have both captured school records in their senior season.

North Carolina went up 4-1 early, but a 4-0 run by the Hokies put them back in it and gave them their first lead of the day. The two teams went back and forth for the remainder of the half, and Tech trailed by just a goal at the break. Meagh Graham had a stellar first half in cage, making ten saves in the first 30 minutes alone. She finished the game with 12.

RISE AND SHINE

The game at Navy marks the third game of the season that will begin before noon. The opening draw of Tech's first round ACC Tournament game was at 11 a.m. Tech also took on Syracuse at 10 a.m. earlier this year. Last year's first round ACC Tournament game is the only other time since Tech joined the league, that it has played in the morning.

HEADED HOME

Ten Hokies head home this weekend as Tech wraps up the 2015 season at Navy. Maryland is home to the most members of this year's lacrosse team. Earlier this year Tech traveled to Syracuse, bringing home seven members of the squad.

HOKIES IN OVERTIME

Tech is 5-1 all-time in overtime games following the victory at Michigan. The Hokies are 2-0 in overtime under Head Coach Megan Burkner, with the other win coming in 2012 when Tech knocked off then-No. 7 Virginia at home.

IT'S THEIRS TO SET

Meg Bartley and Megan Will have both become career Tech record holders this season. Bartley became Tech's draw controls leader after winning the opening draw of the second session of overtime in Tech's win at Michigan, and currently has 285 in her career. Will became the points leader at Tech with three goals and an assist against North Carolina in the ACC Tournament last week. She has 222 points in her career.

RECORD WATCH

Megan Will just claimed the points record, and ranks second on the scoring list. She has spent the season chasing her cousin, Dawn Will's scoring and points records. Megan ranks second with 173 career goals. She is also tied for fifth all-time with 49 career assists.

Will is one of just two players to rank among the all-time top 10 in all three offensive categories (Allie Emala 08-11).

Meg Bartley, who holds the all-time draws record at Tech, notched a spot on the all-time scoring list, ranking ninth with 111 goals to date.

Meghan Macera joined Bartley on the all-time draws list, as she has won 133 so far, good for fifth.

SCORING AT WILL

Senior Megan Will is currently in the midst of a 21-game scoring streak that dates back to last season. The Bel Air, Maryland, native scored a hat trick in the ACC Tournament and put away five goals at Virginia prior to that.

Will has scored at least three goals in 16 of the last 21 games, as she climbs all three all-time offensive stat lists at Tech.

BARTLEY, AN UNEXPECTED SURPRISE

Senior Meg Bartley walked on to the Tech lacrosse team in the fall of 2011 and as the 2012 season began she made a quick and efficient impact. The Lewes, Delaware, native earned a starting job on attack by the fifth game, after scoring four goals and assisting another against UC Davis at home and has been a staple in the lineup ever since.

A DIFFERENT WINTER BREAK

Senior Jack Boissonneault had a very busy winter break this year as she traveled for class to Ecuador. The environmental science major explored the Galapagos and the Amazon, as well as other Ecuadorian towns, doing research and exploring the local culture.

RUN FOR REMEMBRANCE

Following its final ACC game, the Tech lacrosse team participated in the 3.2 for 32, an annual run at Tech to remember those lost on April 16, 2007. As April Saturdays are often gamedays for the Hokies, this was the first time the team was able to participate.

SR | A | Bel Air, Md.

- Named to the All-ACC First Team. Was a third team honoree last season.
 - Leads the team with 53 goals, 66 points.
 - Currently in the midst of a 21-game scoring streak.
 - Broke the Tech career points record with four points against North Carolina in the ACC Tournament (222).
 - Second all-time at Tech with 173 goals.
 - One of just two players to rank in all three career categories at Tech.
 - Chasing her cousin, Dawn Will's scoring record.
 - Has made 59 consecutive starts, only missing two starts in her career.
- Season high goals: 5 vs UVA; Career high goals: 6, twice
Season high points: 6 three times; Career high points: 8 vs Coastal 2014

19 MEG BARTLEY

SR | A | Lewes, Del.

- Leads the team with 83 draws, second with 37 goals.

 - Scored the game-winner in overtime at Michigan, broke the school draws record in overtime as well.

SR | A | Cary, N.C.

JR | D | Westminster, Md.

- Versatile defender with the ability to play the entire field.

- Leads the team with 18 caused turnovers, adds 11 goals, an assist, 53 draws and 31 ground balls.
- Has missed only one start in her career.
- Ranks fifth all-time on Tech's career draws list.

33 MEAGH GRAHAM

SO | G | Rockville, Md.

- Hasn't missed a start in goal since arriving at Tech.
- Has a 5-11 record on the year.
- Made 13 saves against Ohio State this year, and 12 against North Carolina during the regular season.
- Had a stellar first half against North Carolina in the ACC Tournament, making 10 first-half stops, and finished the game with 12 saves.
- Aggressive in cage, not afraid to come out to defend or break up a pass.
