SPRING BREAK 2K18

- The Hokies return home to close out Spring Break after spending almost a week out west in Colorado. Tech took on the Colorado Buffaloes on March 4 and the Denver Pioneers on March 8.
- Tech went 1-1 out west and must now turn their attention to the Irish for an ACC contest. A win would take the Hokies to the top of the ACC standings.

THE JOHN SUNG EFFECT

- Virginia Tech is 11-122 all-time against ranked teams, however the Hokies have found success under John Sung.
- Four of those wins have come in the past two season under head coach John Sung. The Hokies have two wins over top 10 programs during that span, both over Duke.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- Senior attacker Tristan McGinley recorded the 100th goal of her career in Tech's last game at Denver, an 11-5 victory. She scored a hat trick, reaching the century mark on her 22nd birthday.
- Her 100 goals ranks 11th in school history, needing just two to crack the top 10 and tie Stephanie Jones with 102.
- McGinley is up to 114 career points.

DEFEATING DUKE (AGAIN)

- Virginia Tech and Duke have matched up 21 times in women's lacrosse dating back to 1997. The Blue Devils won the first 19 games in that series. That all changed with the arrival of John Sung in Blacksburg.
- Coach Sung and the Hokies have defeated a ranked Duke squad two years in a row, winning 11-6 in Durham in 2017 and this season's 17-14 contest from Blacksburg.

NEWCOMERS HAVING AN IMPACT

- Paige Petty, a freshman from Bernardsville, New Jersey has started every game that she has played this season in the midfield. Petty has 14 goals, the second most on the squad and has been effective at corralling the draw, winning 17 on the season.
- Julia Bolte, a transfer from Oregon has stepped into a starting role in the attack. She dished out five assists in the Hokies' win over Campbell.
- Emma Crooks, had a coming out party against Campbell when she earned her first career start. The midfielder scored eight goals and recorded nine points on the afternoon. Those eight goals are tied for the second most a Hokie has ever had in a single

MEAGH GRAHAM BACK IN GOAL

R-Senior Meagh Graham returns for another season in goal for the Hokies. Last season she set the program record for lowest goals against average at 9.64 as she helped Tech win 11 games for the first time since the 1999 season.

HOKIES AT HOME

- The Hokies are back inside the friendly confines of the Indoor Practice Facility where they own a 4-1 record on the season, with the only setback coming in the season opener to USC, who was ranked eighth nationally at the time.
- In Sung's two years at the helm, the Hokies are 9-2 in games played in that venue.
- The contest against Notre Dame is scheduled to be the final game of the season played indoors, with the next three games played at Thompson Field and Senior Day played inside Lane Stadium.

- While the full name of the school is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, the school is commonly referred to as "Virginia Tech."
- Founded in 1872, as Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College, the university changed its named to Virginia Polytechnic Institute in 1896.
- Fans of the athletic department, as well as media covering the Hokies, shortened the name to VPI, but it eventually became Virginia Tech.
- The "State University" was added in 1970 to bring the official title to what it is today.
- Those covering Hokie athletics are asked to refer to the university as simply "Virginia Tech."
- Virginia Tech University, VPI and SU, VPI&SU, VT or VA Tech are not recognized names

• Head coach John Sung took over the program in the summer of 2016 and transformed the Hokies into a more competitive side. In his first season, Tech won 11 games, which included two wins over ranked ACC opposition for the first time ever. In 2017, Sung and the Hokies ascended as high as No. 12 in the poll, Tech;s highest ranking ever. · His first season also brought a school record of goals, points scored and Meagh Graham recorded the program's lowest ever goals against average. John Sung joined Virginia Tech after building the Winthrop University program from scratch beginning in May of 2011. He oversaw the program's rapid ascent as a regional powerhouse after beginning competition in 2013. In the program's third season, Sung led Winthrop to a 17-4 record, as the Eagles qualified for the NCAA Tournament after winning both the Big South regular-season and tournament titles. In 2016, Winthrop went 20-3, winning the Big South Tournament championship and advancing to another NCAA Tournament. The 2016 season marked the team's second consecutive Big South regular-season and tournament titles. The 2015 and 2016 Big South Coach of the Year, Sung formerly was the chair of the NCAA Division I Lacrosse Committee and also serves on the U.S. Lacrosse Convention Education Committee. His 2015 squad set Big South single-season records for points, goals (314), free-position goals (67), shots (633), shots on goal (459), ground balls (384), draw controls (312), and caused turnovers (213). In 2016, Winthrop scored 301 goals, including 58 free-position goals. The Eagles set Big South single-season marks for shots (662), ground balls (434), and caused turnovers (266). In addition to compiling a 54-26 overall record at Winthrop, Sung led the Haudenosaunee Nation to the quarterfinals of the 2013 Federation of International Lacrosse World Cup held in Canada. The team finished in seventh place out of a total of 19 teams. He also coached the team in the 2009 Federation of International Lacrosse in the Czech Republic. Sung's ascent as an NCAA coach began at Division III Adrian College in Michigan, where he started the program from the ground up and compiled a 46-19 overall record. His 2011 squad started the season 1-4 before registering 15 consecutive victories to earn a berth in the NCAA Division III Tournament. After posting a 6-7 overall record in its first season in 2008, the program went 10-4 in 2009, 14-3 in 2010 and 16-5 in 2011. Before beginning the program at Adrian College, Sung spent five years as the assistant women's club lacrosse coach at the University of Michigan, setting the groundwork for that program to eventually become a varsity sport in the Big Ten. The Wolverines accumulated a 93-22 record during this tenure.

• A longtime trainer of goalies, Sung has held various coaching positions with Birmingham Seaholm High School and the Detroit Lacrosse Club. He has been the assistant director of the Great Lakes Women's Lacrosse Camp since 1997. In addition to his work at various levels in the lacrosse community, Sung has a wealth of sales and management experience in the private sector.
