The Hokies enter the game 11-1 on the season ... Duke is 12-1 this season ... Duke is ranked fifth in both the AP and coaches polls ... This is the conference opener for both teams.

Last Time Out: VT 87, UMBC 70

The Hokies closed out the non-conference portion of the regular season with an 87-70 win over UMBC in Cassell Coliseum on Wednesday night ... **Chris Clarke** recorded his second consecutive double-double, with a career-high 22 points to go with 12 rebounds ... **Ahmed Hill** added 18 points, as five Hokies scored in double figures.

Series Against the Blue Devils

This is the 54th all-time meeting between the two schools ... The Blue Devils lead the series, 45-8 ... Duke has won the last nine meetings, most recently an 82-58 win in Durham last season ... Duke has won the last three games played in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech is 2-6 against the Blue Devils in Cassell Coliseum.

Clarke Steps Up

In the Hokies' win over The Citadel, **Chris Clarke** recorded the Hokies' first-ever triple-double, scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and dishing out a career-high 10 assists ... Clarke is one of two ACC players and 16 players nationally with a triple-double this season ... Since that triple-double, Clarke has recorded two consecutive double-doubles, in the wins over Charleston Southern and UMBC.

Leading the Way

Ahmed Hill has made quite a comeback for the Hokies ... Hill missed the 2015-16 season following knee surgery ... In perhaps his most impactful game, Hill led the Hokies with 20 points and nine rebounds in the win over Ole Miss ... Both numbers tied then-career-highs for Hill ... He scored six of the Hokies' final nine points in the contest, including going 4-of-4 from the line in the final 16 seconds ... Then in the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Hill set a new career-high with 22 points and also handed out a career-high four assists ... He currently leads the ACC and is 30th nationally in three-point field goal percentage.

More Med

Over the last four games, **Ahmed Hill** has scored a total of 80 points, for a 20.0 ppg during that span ... He leads the team in made three-pointers.

Also Hot

Continuing that thought, over the last four games, **Chris Clarke** has scored a total of 64 points, grabbed 40 rebounds and has a triple-double and two double-doubles ... Over the past four games, Clarke is averaging 16.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 4.8 assists.

A Balancing Act

The Hokies had seven players score in double figures in the win over The Citadel, the most since Tech placed seven players in double figures in a 104-74 win over Rider on Dec. 19, 1984 in Cassell Coliseum ... Last season, six players scored in double figures on Dec. 13, 2015 in a win over Lamar ... Tech has had at least five players score in double figures in each of the last three games.

A Baker's Dozen in a Row

The Hokies have won 13 consecutive home games, beginning with the 60-57 win over Clemson on Feb. 6, 2016 ... This is the longest home winning streak for the Hokies since the 2009-10 season, when the Hokies won 14 consecutive home games.

On to the ACC

With the win over UMBC, the Hokies closed out the non-conference portion of the 2016-17 regular season with an 11-1 record, including wins in the last six games ... This season, the Hokies have wins over team from the Big Ten (twice), SEC, and Mountain West conferences.

A New High for J Rob

In the Hokies' 87-70 win over UMBC, **Justin Robinson** made four of his sixth three-point field goal attempts ... That sets a new career-high for the sophomore ... Senior **Seth Allen** joined him in that game, also making four of the Hokies' 11 three-points.

Bunches of 3s

So far this season, through 12 games, the Hokies have recorded six games of at least 10 three-point field goals ... The Hokies are third in the ACC in three-pointers made ... Tech made a season-high 12 three-pointers in the win over High Point.

Fast Start

The Hokies are off to a 11-1 start this season ... This marks the team's best start through 12 games since the 2009-10 season, when Tech started the campaign 12-1 ... The Hokies finished the month of November 6-1 overall and is 5-0 so far in December ... This is the first time the Hokies have been 10 games over .500 since the 2010-11 season.

Big Stats for LeDay

Zach LeDay has posted some great numbers for the Hokies this season ... LeDay has scored in double figures in 11 of the 12 games so far this season, including three games of 20-or-more-points ... He leads the Hokies in scoring, at 16.5 points per game and is second on the team in rebounding, at 7.5 boards per game.

Ty Likes 3s

So far this season, **Ty Outlaw** has made 16 field goals ... Of that number, 14 have come from three-point range ... Outlaw is shooting 40.0 percent from the field, which improves to 42.4 percent from three-point territory.

From the Start

Entering today's game, the Hokies have used the same starting line-up in each of the first 12 games ... Last season, the Hokies used 12 different starting line-ups.

A Fine Start

Khadim Sy made his collegiate debut in the win over Maine ... The freshman post earned the start and had a solid six points, four rebounds and team-high three blocked shots in the win ... In the win over High Point, Sy recorded his first double-figure scoring game of his career, with 14 points on 6-of-9 from the field and a team-high six rebounds ... Sy took it a step further in the win over New Mexico, as he grabbed a team-high 10 rebounds, the most for him this season ... He matched the career-high in points with 14 points in the win over The Citadel ... Sy is averaging 6.1 points and 3.9 rebounds per game in 13.4 minutes per game.

Triple Digits

The Hokies scored 113 points in the win over The Citadel ... That is the most since scoring 116 points in a double overtime win over Duquesne in Cassell Coliseum on March 18, 2009 in the first round of the 2009 NIT ... It is the most points for the Hokies in a regulation game since a 115-87 win at Florida Atlantic on Dec. 28, 1993 ... It is the most in a home, regulation game since Feb. 13, 1988, when the Hokies defeated Cincinnati, 115-11, in a Metro Conference game.

Big 2nd Half

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech trailed 44-40 at the intermission ... The Hokies outscored the Bulldogs, 73-27, in the second half ... The 73 points is tied for the most points in any half for the Hokies and the most against Division I competition ... Tech scored 73 points in the second half in a 116-64 home win over Division III Johns Hopkins on Nov. 30, 1981 ... It is 13 points more than Tech scored in the first half against High Point earlier this season, the season-high for Tech until The Citadel game.

Cleaning the Glass

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech out rebounded the Bulldogs, 52-28 ... The 24-rebound margin is the most for the Hokies this season and the first time this season Tech has had a double-figure rebounding margin in a game ... The 24-rebound margin is the most for a Virginia Tech team since Tech out rebounded Jacksonville State, 54-29, in the second game of last season.

Not Marginal

In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, Tech won by 42 points ... That is the Hokies' largest margin of victory since defeating Monmouth, 91-46, in a Preseason NIT game in Cassell Coliseum on Nov. 14, 2011.

The Century Mark

When the Hokies defeated The Citadel, 113-71, on Dec. 17, it marked the 101st time in school history that Tech has scored at least 100 points ... Tech is now 95-6 all-time in such games ... Tech is 91-3 all-time in regulation games in which it has scored at least 100 points ... The Hokies are 70-1 in 100-point home games ... In games in which Tech has scored at least 113 points, the Hokies are 18-0, 16-0 in non-overtime games and 16-0 in such home games.

What a Sellout, x3

The Virginia Tech Athletics Department has announced that today's ACC opener against Duke and the Feb. 12 game against Virginia are officially sold out ... Tech will do a student lottery for each game ... It is the second and third sellouts of the season, following the sellout of the home opener against Maine on Nov. 11 ... Today's game sold out less than 24 hours after single game ACC tickets went on sale to Hokie Club members and season ticket holders ... There were no general public sales for either game ... Single game tickets went on sale to the general public on Dec. 14.

Some Good Numbers for the Hokies

The Hokies have won seven consecutive games ... Going back to last season, the Hokies have won 18 of their last 21 games ... **Buzz Williams** improved his overall record at Virginia Tech to 42-38.

Clarke in a Giving Mood

Last season, **Chris Clarke** recorded 33 assists in 22 games for the Hokies ... His high was four assists in wins over Lamar and Florida State ... This season, through 12 games, Clarke has dished out 46 assists ... In the win over High Point, Clarke registered six assists and had five assists each in the wins over VMI and Ole Miss ... He smashed that number in the win over The Citadel, when he recorded a career-high 10 assists ... Last season he averaged 1.5 assists per game and this season, that has risen to 4.0 assists per game ... His 10 assists in The Citadel game is the most assists by a Hokie since **Devin Wilson** had 11 assists in a loss to No. 4 Duke on Feb. 25, 2015.

Not Many Points

The Hokies allowed Nebraska just 53 points in the third-place game of the Wooden Legacy ... That is the fewest points allowed by the Hokies since Tech defeated Grambling State, 87-52, on Dec. 19, 2015 ... It is the lowest point total of a Virginia Tech opponent from a Power 5 conference since Virginia defeated the Hokies, 50-47, on Jan. 25, 2015.

Hokies vs. Ranked Teams

Tech is 32-172 all-time against teams ranked in the AP poll ... The Hokies are 15-64 against nationally-ranked teams since joining the ACC for the 2004-05 season ... This is the Hokies' first game against a ranked team this season ... The last time the Hokies defeated a nationally-ranked team was March 5, 2016, when Tech defeated No. 7 Miami, 77-62, in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech has won its last two home games against nationally-ranked teams, both ranked in the top 10.

Analytics and Such

According to Kenpom.com, the Hokies are ranked 36th nationally ... Tech is fifth in steal percentage, eighth in free throw rate, 31st in two-point percentage, 32nd in raw offensive efficiency and 39th nationally in adjusted offensive efficiency and three-point percentage.

What A Trip!

Earlier this season, the Hokies returned from an epic 10-day, four-game road trip, that included stops in Anaheim, California and Ann Arbor, Michigan ... Tech was 3-1 on the trip, all against top-level competition and highlighted by a 73-70 win at Michigan in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... Tech also posted wins against New Mexico and Nebraska and suffered a close, 68-65, loss to Texas A&M.

Here You Go

Seth Allen was in quite the giving mood in the win over UMES ... Allen tied a career-high with eight assists, while only committing one turnover in 31 minutes of action ... The eight assists was tied for the most by a Hokies this season at that point ... Allen also added 11 points, a blocked shot and a steal in the win.

On The List

Seth Allen has been named to the Bob Cousy Award watch list for the 2016-17 season ... The award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

Hamilton to Miss Remainder of Season

Johnny Hamilton had surgery on a ruptured flexor tendon in his left thumb and will miss the remainder of the season ... The surgery took place in mid-December ... Hamilton appeared in three games this season and 20 games in his two-year Virginia Tech career.

What A Day!

Justin Robinson had his best-ever performance for the Hokies in their win over New Mexico ... The sophomore point guard had a career-high 22 points, to go along with a career-high-tying eight assists ... Robinson also played a career-high 40 minutes, but did not commit a turnover in the game ... He added 14 points in the loss to Texas A&M and 11 points and four assists in the win at Michigan ... He had 14 points and six assists in the win over The Citadel, 12 points against CSU and 12 points in the win over UMBC.

446 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 446 consecutive games, the most in school history ... The Hokies have hit a three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

Putting a Lid on the Hoop

The Hokies allowed Nebraska just 29.8 percent from the floor in the win on Nov. 27 ... That is the lowest opponent field goal percentage for Tech this season and the lowest since Tech held VMI to 25.7 percent from the floor on Nov. 21, 2015.

Hokies in the National Stats

Through the games of Dec. 28, Tech is 10th nationally in won-lost percentage, 25th in field goal percentage, 26th in fewest fouls and scoring margin, 28th in assist/turnover ratio, 29th in personal fouls per game and scoring offense, 34th in defensive rebounds per game and 38th in assists per game ... Individually, **Ahmed Hill** is 30th in three-point field goal percentage ... **Chris Clarke** is 30th in defensive rebounds per game and has recorded one of only 16 triple doubles this season.

The Hokies had 19 assists in the win over VMI ... Combined with the 24 assists against High Point, this marks the first time that the Hokies have had 19-or-more assists in back-to-back games since the second and third games of the 2011-12 season ... Tech had 20 assists against both Monmouth and FIU ... In the win over New Mexico, the Hokies dished out 20 assists and 30 assists in the win over The Citadel.

Big Week

When the Hokies defeated Nebraska, 66-53, in Anaheim, California in the Wooden Legacy and Michigan, 73-70, in Ann Arbor in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, it marked the first time in school history that Tech defeated Big Ten schools in back-to-back games ... In 2009, the Hokies won at Iowa and at Penn State in December, but the games were not back-to-back ... The win over Nebraska marked the Hokies' first win over a Big Ten team since Nov. 27, 2012 (exactly four years to the day), when Tech defeated Iowa, 95-79, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Cassell Coliseum ... It was the Hokies first win over a Big Ten school away from Blacksburg since the Hokies downed the Hawkeyes, 70-64, in Iowa City in the 2009 ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... As a side note, the Hokies won two games against Big Ten schools in the 2009-10 season (also won 66-64 at Penn State that season).

Balanced Time

The Hokies have only one player averaging 30 minutes of action per game this season ... Six Hokies are averaging between 24 and 32 minutes of action this season ... Eight Hokies are averaging in double-figures in minutes played so far this season.

HEAD COACH BUZZ WILLIAMS



In his two years at Virginia Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very

effective approach – "Get Better."

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature. Williams has compiled a 42-38 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new highs in this area. And while he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure. In his nine-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 195-124.

"The growth of the Hokies' basketball program and the renewed energy under Buzz Williams in his first two seasons has been remarkable," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "We've seen improvement in all facets. He's an educator first and foremost. He loves his players. They play hard for him. Everyone within the program and around the department has embraced Buzz's work ethic, passion, and attention to detail. We certainly have positive momentum and want to do all we can to keep it going. We believe in Coach Williams and his staff. Exciting times in Blacksburg."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA

Division I level for 20 seasons, and 2016-17 will mark his 10th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the



nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.



The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
