The Hokies enter the tournament 21-9 overall and 10-8 in ACC action ... Tech is the seventh seed in the event.

Last Time Out: WF 89, VT 84

The Hokies dropped the regular season finale to Wake Forest, 89-84, in Cassell Coliseum on Senior Day ... **Zach LeDay** led the Hokies with 24 points and 10 rebounds, recording his fifth double-double of the season ... Fellow senior **Seth Allen** added 20 points for the Hokies.

Seniors are Honored

Virginia Tech senior **Seth Allen** has been named the ACC 6th Man of the Year, in voting by a panel of coaches, media and radio broadcasters ... Allen averaged 13.1 points per game for the Hokies, which improved to 14.6 ppg in ACC play ... He scored the game-winning basket in five of the Hokies' 10 ACC victories ... Allen, along with fellow senior **Zach LeDay** were named honorable mention All-ACC as well ... This is the second consecutive season that LeDay has been named honorable mention ... LeDay leads the Hokies in scoring and rebounding this season ... In Atlantic Coast Sports Media Association voting, both were named honorable mention All-ACC and LeDay was named the league's Sixth Man of the Year.

Heading to The Big Apple

Virginia Tech will make its 13th appearance in the ACC Tournament this week in Brooklyn ... Tech finished the regular season tied for seventh place and won the tie-breaker with Syracuse and Miami ... Tech is the seventh-seed and will play Wake Forest on Wednesday night ... The winner of that game will play second-seed Florida State at 7 p.m., on Thursday night ... The Hokies lost to Wake Forest (at home) and swept the Eagles this season.



More on Tech in the ACC Tournament

Virginia Tech is the seventh seed in the event ... This is the first time Tech is the seventh seed ... Tech has been seeded higher than seventh in five tournaments, once as a three-seed, three times as a four-seed and last season as the sixth seed.

The Hokies in Barclays

Tech has played in Barclays Center three times over the years, with an 0-3 record ... Tech has never played an ACC team in the building ... Tech's last appearance in the building was on Dec. 22, 2015, when the Hokies lost to St. Joseph's, 79-62.

Series Against the Demon Deacons

The Hokies lead the series, 32-31 ... Wake Forest defeated the Hokies, 89-84, in Blacksburg on March 4 in the only meeting of the season between the two schools ... Tech is 2-3 in neutral court games against Wake Forest and 2-0 in ACC Tournament games against the Demon Deacons ... Virginia Tech is 12-7 against the Demon Deacons since Tech joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Tech is 3-2 against Wake Forest under **Buzz Williams** and 1-0 in ACC Tournament games against Wake Forest under Williams.

Tech in Conference Tournaments

This will be the 13th ACC Tournament for the Hokies and the 14th-consecutive conference tournament appearance for the Hokies ... Tech is 8-12 in ACC Tournament action ... The Hokies have a combined 34-53 all-time record in post-season conference tournaments ... Tech is 11-20 all-time against current ACC members in post-season conference tournaments.

The ACC Tournament

This is the 64th annual ACC Tournament ... This is the first ACC Tournament played at Barclays Center ... The tournament will return to Barclays Center next season ... This is the first time the ACC Tournament has been played in New York and is the first time the tournament has been played north of the DC Metro area ... Greensboro has hosted 26 ACC Tournaments ... The next most-common venue is Reynolds Coliseum in Raleigh (13) ... Of the 10 other arenas to host the event, three, the Capital Centre in Landover, Maryland, the Charlotte Coliseum and the Omni in Atlanta, are no longer standing.

First Games in the ACC Tournament

Since Tech has been in the ACC, the post-season tournament has had multiple formats and brackets, depending on the number of teams in the league and competing in the tournament ... Virginia Tech is 7-5 in its first game in each year's tournament ... Tech has won its first game in the ACC Tournament both years since **Buzz Williams** took over as head coach ... Tech is 2-2 in ACC Tournament games under Williams.

An Oddity

Virginia Tech will face Wake Forest in its first game in the 2017 ACC Tournament ... This is the first time the Hokies have played the same ACC team in consecutive games ... The last time the Hokies played the same team in consecutive games was in 1966-67 season, when Tech ended the regular season losing at Toledo, 90-71 and then, one week later, defeated the Rockets, 82-76, in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Lexington, Kentucky ... Tech advanced to the Elite Eight that season.

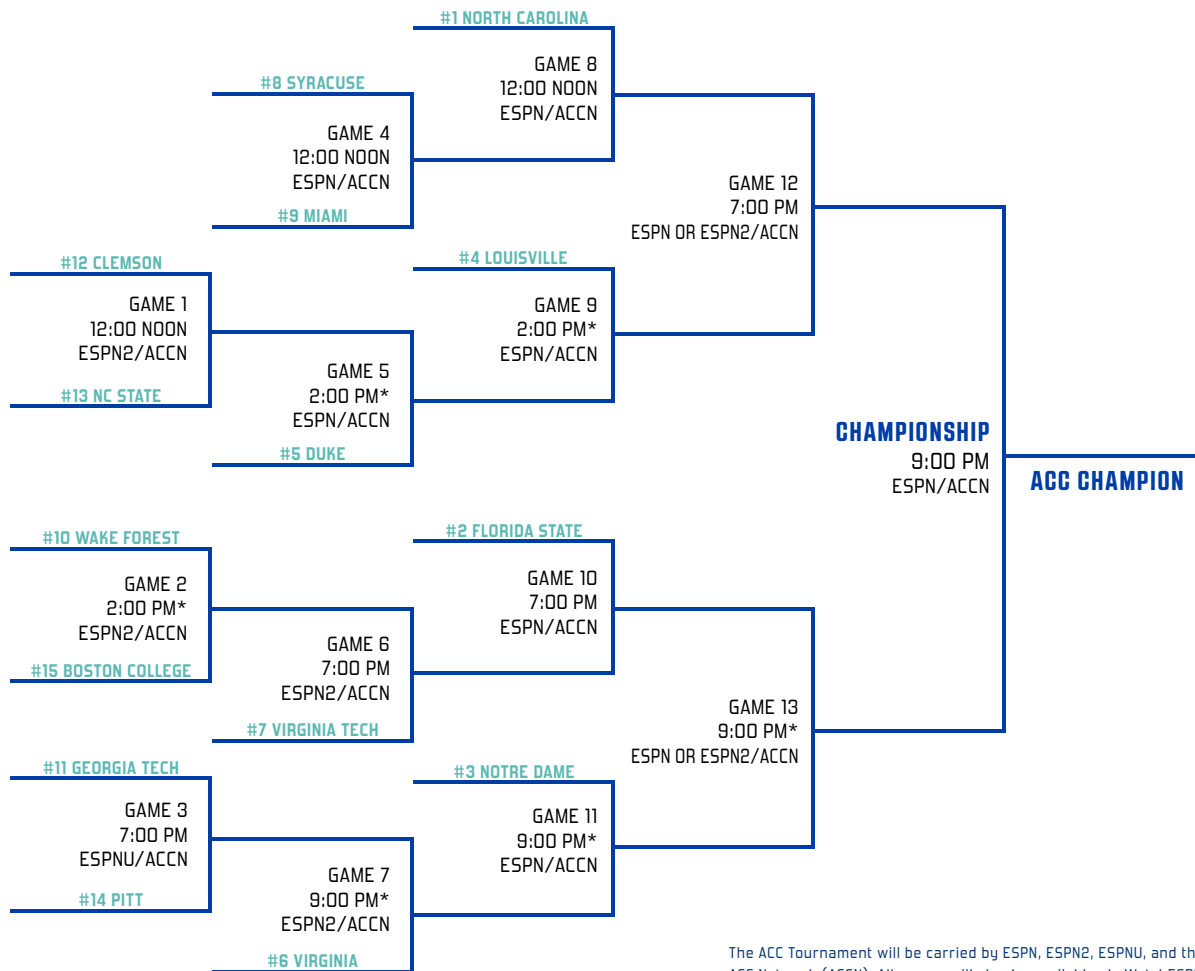

Ty Heats Things UP!

Ty Outlaw has really turned up his output in the last six games ... In the win over Miami, Outlaw set a new school record with eight made three-point field goals, breaking the old mark of seven ... He scored a career-high 24 points ... At Louisville, Outlaw scored a then career-high 19 points ... He made a then career-high five three-pointers in 35 minutes of action ... He was 7-of-8 from the field, including 5-6 from three-point range ... He also grabbed seven rebounds, tying a career-high and setting a personal best in an ACC game ... In the win at Boston College, Outlaw had 16 points, making all five of his three-point attempts ... He also had seven rebounds to lead the Hokies in a career-high 38 minutes.

Reaching a Milestone

In the Hokies' 91-75 win at Boston College, **Justin Bibbs** scored his 1,000th career point ... He became the 45th Hokie to score 1,000 career points and currently has 1,016 points.

In the loss to Wake Forest on Saturday, **Zach LeDay** scored his 1,000th point as a Hokie ... He became the 46th Hokie to score 1,000 points and currently has 1,010 points.

Justin is Honored

Justin Robinson has been named to the 2017 All-ACC Academic team ... To be eligible, you must have a 3.0 GPA ... Robinson makes the team for the first time.

Top 25 Wins

When the Hokies defeated No. 25/25 Miami on Feb. 27, it marked Tech's third victory over a nationally-ranked team this season ... The last time Tech pulled off that feat was in the 2006-07 season, when Tech was 3-1 against nationally-ranked teams and the three wins were at No. 5 Duke, home against No. 1 North Carolina and at No. 4 North Carolina ... These two seasons are the only time Tech has three wins against nationally-ranked teams and Tech only has five other seasons when the team won twice against ranked teams.

Strong Play by Allen

Seth Allen has scored in double figures in 13 of the 15 games since returning from an injury which caused him to miss the Florida State game ... In that span, he is averaging 15.3 points per game ... Allen scored 20 points in the win over Virginia and made a big three-pointer late in the win over Pittsburgh ... He scored 25 points in the loss at Louisville and made the game-winning three-pointer in the final seconds in the home win over Clemson ... He scored 20 points in his final regular season game in Cassell Coliseum against Wake Forest on Senior Day.

Solid Stats for LeDay

Zach LeDay has scored in double figures in 28 of the 30 games, including four games of 20-or-more-points and five double-doubles ... He leads the Hokies in scoring, at 15.6 points per game and in rebounding (among active players), at 7.1 boards per game ... In the win over Syracuse, he tied his ACC-high of 22 points ... LeDay grabbed his 400th Virginia Tech rebound against Notre Dame ... He recorded his third double-double of the season in the loss at Miami and his fourth in the win at Pittsburgh ... LeDay snapped a streak of 23 consecutive double-figure scoring games in the win over Miami, but bounced back with his fifth double-double of the season with a team-high 24 points and 10 rebounds in the regular season finale against Wake Forest ... In that game, he recorded his 1,000th point as a Hokie ... LeDay has three 20-10 double-doubles this season and seven for his Virginia Tech career.

The Hokies at 21

Virginia Tech enters the tournament 21-9 overall and 10-8 in ACC play ... The win at Boston College gave the Hokies back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons ... The 21 wins are the most for the Hokies since winning 22 games in the 2010-11 season ... The 10 ACC wins ties the school record for ACC wins in a regular season.

Board Control

In the Hokies' win at Boston College, Tech out rebounded the Eagles, 27-18 ... The 18 rebounds allowed sets a new school, ACC record for fewest rebounds allowed in a game ... The previous low was 19 rebounds in Feb. 12, 2012, against Boston College in Cassell Coliseum ... Last Saturday, Tech allowed BC just four offensive rebounds, the lowest amount for a Tech ACC opponent this season ... Tech allowed Miami just five offensive rebounds on Feb. 27.

Anything But Marginal

The Hokies defeated Boston College, 91-75, in the Conte Forum on Feb. 25 ... The 16-point margin of victory was the most for the Hokies in a road ACC game since Jan. 20, 2011, when Tech defeated Maryland, 74-57, in College Park ... It is only the third time since the Hokies joined the ACC that Tech has won a conference road game by more than 15 points.

Percentage Talk

The Hokies shot 75.0 percent in the second half of the win at Boston College, their highest percentage in a half this season ... The Hokies shot 66.7 percent from three-point territory in both wins over Boston College this season ... The two BC games tie the school's record for three-point percentage in an ACC game ... Tech shot 66.7 percent from three-point range in a 76-62 win at Wake Forest on Feb. 22, 2011 ... The Hokies shot 59.2 percent from the floor in the loss at Louisville, the team's third-best of the season and best in ACC play ... Tech shot 59.1 percent in the win over Boston College on Jan. 22.

Conference Wins

The Hokies finished the regular season 10-8 in ACC play ... The 10 wins is tied for the most ACC wins for the Hokies since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... The Hokies have only won more than 10 games in any conference twice, in the 1995-96 season, when the Hokies were 13-3 in their first season in the Atlantic 10 and 11-4 in the 1956-57 season in the Southern Conference ... The Hokies were 10-4 in the 1984-85 season in the Metro Conference ... Tech's best conference record in the Big East Conference was 7-9 in the 2003-04 season, in the school's final season in the league.

Playing the Percentages From Three

The Hokies are shooting 40.5 percent from beyond the arc this season ... The school record for three-point field goal percentage for a season is 39.5 percent, set in the 1995-96 season ... The ACC's best percentage from three-point land since the arc was moved beginning with the 2008-09 season is Virginia's 40.3 percent last season ... Tech's 40.9 is the best for any ACC team since Wake Forest shot 42.1 percent in the 1995-96 season ... The Hokies are shooting 41.4 percent from three-point territory in ACC games this season ... The school record for three-point percentage in ACC games is 38.7 percent in the 2014-15 season.

Playing More Percentages

The Hokies are shooting 49.4 percent from the field in ACC games this season ... The school, ACC record is 47.3 percent in the 2006-07 season ... The Hokies are shooting 73.8 percent from the line in ACC play this season, the third-best since joining the league ... The school, ACC record is 75.5 percent in the 2009-10 season.

On Top of the List

Justin Bibbs is 182-420 from three-point range for his career, good for 43.3 percent ... He is currently fourth all-time in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC, having passed Rusty LaRue of Wake Forest in the win at Boston College ... He is currently tops at Virginia Tech, as the existing school mark is 40.9 percent, set by Brian Chase from 1999-2003 ... In the last seven games, Bibbs is 21-41 from three-point range, for 51.2 percent.

3s Company

The Hokies were 10-20 from three-point range in the win over No. 25/25 Miami on Feb. 27 ... This was the fourth consecutive game shooting 50.0 percent or higher from beyond the arc ... It was the fifth time in ACC play that Tech has shot 50.0 percent or better from beyond the arc and the seventh such game this season ... It was the fifth consecutive game of 10-or-more three-pointers for the Hokies ... Tech is the only ACC team to accomplish that feat.

The Shot

The Hokies defeated Clemson, 71-70, in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 21 ... Trailing 70-68 with 7.4 seconds remaining, **Seth Allen** made a three-pointer from the top of the key with 3.8 second remaining to give the Hokies the win ... It was Allen's second game-winning basket in as many home games, as he scored the game-winner in double overtime against UVa ... He has hit the eventual game-winner in four of the Hokies' nine ACC wins this season.

Home is Where the Wins Are

The Hokies finished the regular season 15-2 at home and 7-2 in home ACC games ... The seven ACC home wins ties the school record for home ACC wins ... Tech was 7-1 at home in the 200-9-10 season and 7-2 at home in conference games last season ... The 15-2 mark is the most home wins since Tech was 17-2 in home games in the 2009-10 season ... The most home wins during the regular season is 15 wins in the 1982-83 season and this season.

Improvement from 3

Last season, **Seth Allen** was 44 of 157 from three-point range, for 28.0 percent ... This season, he has made 47 of 101 three-point attempts, for 46.5 percent from three-point range ... He is 31 of 65 (47.7 percent) from three-point range in ACC games this season.

Lending an Assist

In the win at Pittsburgh, **Justin Robinson** tied his then-career-high with eight assists ... In the home win over Clemson, he had eight assists with three turnovers ... In the Pitt win, he also dished out his 200th career assist in just his 60th career game ... In the win at Boston College, Robinson set a new career-high and tied the school's ACC game record with 11 assists ... Robinson finished the regular season with 88 assists in ACC action, setting a new school record for assists in an ACC season ... He has 47 assists and just 19 turnovers in the last seven games ... He has 238 career assists, to just 133 career turnovers ... With his six assists against Wake Forest, Robinson has 141 assists this season, tied for the seventh-highest single season total in Virginia Tech history.

Making Shots

The Hokies lead the ACC field goal percentage and three-point field goal percentage in conference games and in all games this season ... Tech is 13th nationally in field goal percentage and seventh in three-point field goal percentage ... Tech shot 49.4 percent from the field in ACC play and is shooting 49.2 percent from the field in all games ... The Hokies shot 51.0 percent from the floor at UNC and are the first ACC opponent to make better than 50 percent of their shots against the Tar Heels ... Tech shot 59.1 percent from the field in the home win over Boston College and 59.2 percent from the field at Louisville ... In the win at Boston College, the Hokies shot a school ACC record 67.4 percent from the floor.

Putting the Ball in the Basket

The Hokies averaged 75.8 points per game in ACC play this season, shattering the old mark of 72.2 points per game in the 2009-10 season ... Tech's 1,364 points in ACC mark betters the old mark of 1,272 set last season ... The Hokies are averaging 79.0 points per game this season ... The last time the Hokies averaged more points per game than that number was in the 1988-89 season, when the Hokies averaged 87.2 points per game ... Tech averaged 75.0 points per game last season, the most since the 1994-95 season (75.4 ppg).

Setting New Marks

The Hokies had 251 assists in ACC play ... The former school record was 220, set in the 2014-15 season ... Tech had 206 assists in ACC games last season ... The Hokies have made 265 three-pointers this season ... The old school record was 241 threes, set in the 2014-15 season.

Moving On Up

The Hokies are shooting 73.0 percent from the free throw line ... Entering the Jan. 18 game against Georgia Tech, the Hokies were shooting 69.8 percent from the line ... Since then, the Hokies have made 200 of 257 free throw attempts, good for 77.8 percent ... Tech shot 73.8 percent from the line in ACC competition.

Whew, That's Close

The Hokies were 10-8 in ACC games this season ... In the last eight victories, the Hokies won by more than three points just twice, in both Boston College games ... Tech won by double digits just three this ACC season, 89-75 over Duke, 83-73 over Syracuse and 91-75 at Boston College ... Tech was 6-2 in ACC games this season decided by five-or-fewer points and 8-3 in all games this season decided by five-or-fewer points ... Eleven ACC games were decided by six-or-fewer points and the Hokies were 7-4 in those games.

What a Sellout, x5

Virginia Tech five sellout games this season ... The sellouts are the home opener against Maine and ACC games against Duke, Notre Dame, Virginia and the regular season finale against Wake Forest ... The Duke game sold out less than 24 hours after single game ACC tickets went on sale to Hokie Club members and season ticket holders.

More on the Gate

With the five sellouts this season, the Hokies are averaging 7,476 per game this season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 6,658 and in the 2014-15 season, Tech averaged 5,744 ... This year's attendance would be the largest for the Hokies since averaging 8,395 in the 2010-11 season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 7,529 for nine ACC home games; this season, Tech averaged 8,047 for ACC home games ... Tech averaged 7,529 last season ... The best-ever ACC average attendance for the Hokies is 9,847 in the 2008-09 season.

In the win at Pitt, **Ahmed Hill** scored his 600th career point.

When **Ty Outlaw** led the Hokies in scoring with a career-high 24 points in the win over No. 25/25 Miami, he became the seventh Hokie to lead the team in scoring this season ... It is the most points that Tech has scored in an ACC non-overtime loss and the second most in any ACC loss.

The Hokies are now 2-4 against nationally-ranked teams this season.

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 464 consecutive games, the most in school history ... The Hokies have hit a three-pointer in every game since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

Giving an Assist

The Hokies dished out 18 assists on 31 made baskets in the win at Boston College ... It was the 10th time this season that the Hokies have had at least 18 assists in a game ... In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, the Hokies dished out a season-high 30 assists, second-most assists in school history.

That Pittsburgh Game

Less than 48 hours after the Hokies' 80-78 double overtime victory over No. 12/13 Virginia, Tech was back on the court in Pittsburgh ... The Hokies played their first game without **Chris Clarke**, who was lost for the season in the UVa win ... Trailing by 11 points at the half and by 13 points early in the second half, Tech recorded its second consecutive double-digit come-from-behind ACC victory ... Tech played eight players, but two played fewer than 10 minutes each ... Although out rebounded 43-29, Tech forced the Panthers into 13 turnovers, while committing just eight ... Those years were the last two of a four consecutive home win streak against UVa ... In the win, **Justin Bibbs** tied the school record for minutes played in an ACC game, with 46 ... Ty Outlaw has made 60 field goals ... Of that number, 48 have come from three-point range ... He was 3-for-5 from three-point range at NC State ... Both of his baskets at Florida State were two-point field goals, the first time this season he has had two, two-pointers in the same game ... He was 5-of-6 from three-point range in the loss at Louisville and 5-of-5 from three in the win at Boston College ... He set a new school record with eight made three-pointers in the win over No. 25/25 Miami.

Earning It

Head coach **Buzz Williams** has announced that **Matt Galloway** has earned a full scholarship for the spring semester ... Galloway, who graduated last May with a degree in history, is currently in graduate school at Virginia Tech ... He joined the team last season as a walk-on.

Last season, the Hokies won two games against top 10 teams, including a home win over No. 7 Miami ... That marked the first time that had happened since Tech defeated three top 10 (actually top 5) teams in the 2006-07 season ... Tech added another Top 5 victory this season, defeating No. 5/5 Duke, 89-75, on Dec. 31 ... Tech is 3-5 against ranked teams this season, 1-2 against top 10 teams.

A Good Night from the Line

The Hokies made 16 of 17 free throw attempts in the win at Clemson, for 94.1 percent ... That marked the third time this season that Tech had shot better than 90 percent from the line ... Tech made 19 of 20 attempts in the win over New Mexico in the Wooden Legacy and 19 of 21 attempts in the win at Michigan in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... The last time the Hokies made at least 94 percent from the line in an ACC game (attempting at least 10 free throws) was on March 4, 2009, when the Hokies made all of their 17 free throw attempts in an 86-78 home win over No. 2 North Carolina ... Tech was 7-of-8 from the line in the home win over Clemson ... The Hokies matched the 16-of-17 from the line against Wake Forest.

Virginia Tech assistant coach **Jamie McNeilly** spent some of his summer in Chile ... He was an assistant coach with the Canadian National team at the FIBA U18 Americas Championship in Valdivia, Chile, a team that featured Virginia Tech signee Nickeil Alexander-Walker and finished with the Silver Medal ... Last summer, he was an assistant with the Canadian team at the FIBA U19 Championship in Heraklion, Greece, where **Justin Bibbs'** USA Basketball team won the gold medal ... McNeilly has contributed to the Canadian National team since 2011.

Seniors Leading the Way

The Hokies' two, fifth-year seniors, **Seth Allen** and **Zach LeDay**, have led by example this season ... The duo are the team's top two scorers and are averaging a combined 28.7 points per game this season ... Allen is second on the team in assists and LeDay leads the team in scoring, rebounds and blocked shots.

Scoring Balance

The Hokies have five players averaging in double figures ... The Hokies have played 11 players this season and eight have scored at least 100 points ... Six players have scored at least 200 points, and four of those have scored more than 300 points ... **Zach LeDay** has scored 467 points this season to lead the Hokies ... In the win over Boston College, the Hokies placed six players in double figures for the second time in ACC play this season (the Duke win was the first).

Up to the Challenge

When the Hokies defeated Nebraska, 66-53, in the Wooden Legacy and Michigan, 73-70, in Ann Arbor in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in the last week in November, it marked the first time in school history that Tech defeated Big Ten schools in back-to-back games ... In 2009, the Hokies won at Iowa and at Penn State in December, but the games were not back-to-back ... The win over Nebraska marked the Hokies' first win over a Big Ten team since Nov. 27, 2012 (exactly four years to the day), when Tech defeated Iowa, 95-79, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Cassell Coliseum ... It was the Hokies first win over a Big Ten school away from Blacksburg since the Hokies downed the Hawkeyes, 70-64, in Iowa City in the 2009 ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

Zach is Honored

Zach LeDay was named to the Wooden Legacy All-Tournament team, following his performance in Anaheim ... LeDay averaged 14.3 points and 5.7 rebounds in the three-game event.

400/200

Zach LeDay enters the ACC Tournament with 467 points and 214 rebounds for the season ... He is the first Hokie with 400 points and 200 rebounds in consecutive seasons since Jeff Allen accomplished the feat in the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons ... If he reaches the 500 point total again this season, he will become the first Hokie with 500 points and 200 rebounds in consecutive seasons since Bryant Matthews accomplished that feat in the 2002-03 and 2003-04 seasons.

BUZZ WILLIAMS



In his three seasons at Virginia Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take

a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 205-132. Williams has compiled a 52-46 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. And while he has been

able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. Six Marquette players made it to the NBA during Williams' tenure.

"The growth of the Hokies' basketball program and the renewed energy under Buzz Williams in his first two seasons has been remarkable," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "We've seen improvement in all facets. He's an educator first and foremost. He loves his players. They play hard for him. Everyone within the program and around the department has embraced Buzz's work ethic, passion, and attention to detail. We certainly have positive momentum and want to do all we can to keep it going. We believe in Coach Williams and his staff. Exciting times in Blacksburg."

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA

Division I level for 20 seasons, and 2016-17 will mark his 10th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the



nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.



The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
