About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter the game 11-3 overall and 0-1 in ACC action ... The Cavaliers are 12-1 overall and 1-0 in conference play ... The Cavaliers are ranked eighth in the AP poll and ninth in the USA Today coaches poll ... Tonight's game is part of the Commonwealth Clash, which is a points-based competition between Virginia Tech and Virginia athletics teams ... The Commonwealth Clash is sponsored by Virginia529, The Official College Savings Plan of Virginia Tech.



Last Time Out: Syracuse 68, VT 56

The Hokies dropped their ACC opener, 68-56, at Syracuse on Sunday night ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** led the Hokies with 19 points and **Justin Bibbs** and **Justin Robinson** added 10 points each for Tech ... The Hokies shot a season-low 34.6 percent from the field.

The Hokies vs. UVA

Tech is 55-90 all-time against the Cavaliers and 16-7 all-time against UVA in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech won the last meeting, 80-78, in double overtime in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 12, 2017 ... The teams split the two meetings in each of the last two seasons, with Tech winning at home in both years ... Tech is 10-16 in ACC regular season games ... Tech is 2-4 against the Cavaliers under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech's last three victories in the series have come against nationally-ranked Cavalier squads.

More About the Tech-UVA Series

This is the Hokies most-played rivalry ... The series dates back to Feb. 20, 1915, when the Cavaliers defeated Tech, 39-21, in Charlottesville ... Along with Blacksburg and Charlottesville, the series has also been played in Roanoke, Lynchburg, Richmond, Salem, Hampton, Norfolk and Greensboro, North Carolina (the 2006 ACC Tournament) ... After many years of neutral site games, the series returned to each campus, beginning in the 2000-01 season, the year Tech joined the Big East Conference ... This has been a home-and-home series since Tech joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season.

A String of Threes

Ahmed Hill has made at least one three-pointer in each of his last 14 games, best in the ACC ... The Virginia Tech school record for most consecutive games with a three-point field goal is 73, by Wally Lancaster.

Seeing the Hokies

The attendance for the Hokies' game at Syracuse on Dec. 31 was 20,688, the second-largest crowd of the season to see the Hokies play (a crowd of 22,690 saw Tech and Kentucky play at Rupp Arena on Dec. 16) ... The Syracuse crowd was the 12th-largest to see a regular season game involving the Hokies.

Commonwealth Notes

Virginia Tech is 431-316 (.577) all-time against schools from Virginia ... Tech is 1-0 this season against Virginia schools, following a 95-68 home win over Radford on Dec. 6 ... The Hokies have played 14 schools from the state all-time ... The only state Division I school that Tech has not played is Hampton ... Tech holds winning records against 10 of the schools and even records against two others.

More About the Commonwealth Clash

The Hokies won last year's Commonwealth Clash ... The clash tied, 11-11, but Tech won the tie-breaker by winning four ACC team titles ... Tech leads this season, 4-1 ... This season's two men's basketball games will count towards half a point each ... The Commonwealth Clash is sponsored by Virginia529, The Official College Savings Plan of Virginia Tech.

Sharing is Good

In the win over The Citadel, the Hokies recorded 36 assists ... That set a new school record for assists in a game, breaking the old mark of 31, set against South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982. In the win over Washington, the Hokies assisted on 23 of their 30 made baskets, good for 76.7 percent ... For the season, Tech has 257 assists on 425 made field goals, for 60.5 percent ... Tech has nine players with at least double figures in assists this season ... The Hokies are 12th nationally and second in the ACC in assists per game.

Wrapping Up the Non-Con Slate

Tech was a perfect 9-0 in home non-conference games ... The Hokies recorded three wins against Power 5 competition in non-conference games and played two, true road games at Power 5 competition ... The Hokies held the advantage in the paint in nine of the 13 games ... Five times during non-conference play, Tech's bench scored 30-or-more points ... **Ahmed Hill** led the Hokies in scoring in non-conference games, averaging 16.3 points per game.

Sy Returns

Khadim Sy has returned to the Virginia Tech men's basketball program ... The sophomore post player from Dakar, Senegal will practice with the team this semester, but will redshirt the 2017-18 season ... He will have three years of eligibility available beginning the Fall 2018.

A Balancing Act

The Hokies enter tonight's game with five players averaging in double figures ... **Ahmed Hill** leads Tech scorers, averaging 15.6 points per game ... Tech has nine players averaging double figures in minutes played this season, with **Justin Bibbs**, at 31.2 minutes played per game the only player averaging more than 30 minutes per game ... Tech has four players averaging more than two assists per game.

Joining the List

In the Hokies' win over Presbyterian, **Justin Robinson** led Tech with four assists ... In doing so, he passed Erick Green into 10th place on the Tech all-time assists list ... Robinson now has 336 career assists in about two and one-half seasons ... He passed Brendan Dunlap into ninth place on the list in the win over North Carolina A&T.

Threes' Points

In the Hokies' win over Maryland-Eastern Shore, Tech made 15 three-point field goals, marking the second time this season Tech has made at least 15 threes ... So far this season, Tech individual players have made at least three, three in a game 18 times ... **Ahmed Hill** was 11-of-15 from three-point territory in the two games in Madison Square Garden in the 2K Classic ... Hill has made at least four three-pointers in a game five times this season and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** has made at least four three-pointers in a game four times this season ... Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in seven games this season.

Hokies in National Stats

As of Jan. 2, the Hokies lead the nation in field goal percentage, are sixth in three-point field goal percentage and ninth in scoring offense ... Tech is 11th scoring margin, 13th in assists per game and 31st in assist/turnover ratio.

Strong from the Line

Justin Bibbs made his first two free throws this season before missing his third attempt of the night, in the game against Saint Louis ... Since then, Bibbs has been 18-of-21 from the line ... He is shooting 83.3 percent from the line this season.

Tech vs. AP Poll

Following the 93-86 loss at No. 8 Kentucky, Tech is 35-179 all-time against ranked teams ... The Hokies are 0-1 against ranked teams this season and were 3-6 against ranked teams last season.

Call It a Comeback

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss in Oxford on Dec. 2, 83-80, in overtime ... In doing so, the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit ... The 16-point comeback is the largest for Tech game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum.

Perfect from the Line

Kerry Blackshear Jr., was 11-for-11 from the free throw line in the win over Radford ... It is the ninth time in school history that a Hokie has shot at least 10 free throws in a game and made all attempted ... The record is 18-for-18 from the line by Rod Wheeler against Richmond on Dec. 28, 1990.

Analytics and All

As of Jan 2, the Hokies are ranked 40th by Kenpom.com ... Tech leads the nation in effective field goal percentage, is fifth in three-point percentage and sixth in two-point percentage ... Tech 11th in raw offensive efficiency and length of possession, 13th in free throw rate, 30th in adjusted offensive efficiency, 33rd in assist percentage and 35th in raw defensive efficiency.

Buzz Williams has announced the signings of **Jonathan Kabongo**, **Jarren McAllister** and **Landers Nolley II** to National Letters of Intent ... The trio will enroll at Virginia Tech in the fall of 2018 ... Kabonogo is a 6-4, 180 lbs., guard from Toronto, Ontario and Putnam Science Academy in Putnam, Connecticut ... McAllister is a 6-4, 185 lbs., guard from Heritage High School in Wake Forest, North Carolina ... Nolley is a 6-7, 210 lbs., shooting guard at Langston Hughes High School in Fairburn, Georgia.

Last Meeting vs. UVa

The Hokies defeated the 12th-ranked Cavaliers, 80-78, in double overtime in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 12, 2017 ... **Seth Allen** hit a jumper in the lane with three seconds remaining to secure the win ... Tech trailed 37-23 at the half, but **Ty Outlaw's** tip-in at the buzzer sent the game to its first of two overtime periods ... Allen led four Hokies in double figures with 20 points ... Tech lost **Chris Clarke** for the remainder of the season when he tore his ACL in the second half ... This was also the game where a shot by the Cavalier's London Perrantes landed and settled on the flange of the rim, causing a held ball situation late in the game.

What's Next?

The Hokies continue this brief homestand on Saturday afternoon, as they host Pittsburgh ... Tip is at noon and the game will be shown live on the ACC Network and the ESPN app.

What is a Hokie?

That's the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics ... The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute ... With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body ... Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today ... Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention ... Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The Hokies' 132 points against The Citadel are the most by an ACC team this season ... Tech's 68.6 percent from the field in that game is also the best for an ACC team this season ... Tech's 36 assists in that game are the most by an ACC team this season.

Selling Out

The Hokies sold out the season opener against Detroit Mercy and the game against The Citadel ... It was announced on Dec. 15 that home games against North Carolina, Duke, Florida State and Miami have all sold out ... The Louisville game is expected to join the list of sell outs.

Big Margin

The Hokies defeated Maryland-Eastern Shore, 93-40 ... The 53-point margin of victory is the largest by a **Buzz Williams**-coached Virginia Tech team, surpassing the 42-point margin of victory over The Citadel last season ... The 40 points scored by Maryland-Eastern Shore are the fewest by an opponent against Virginia Tech under Williams ... The 53-point margin is the largest for the Hokies since Jan. 2, 2011, when the Hokies defeated Mount St. Mary's, 99-34 ... That is also the last game the Hokies held an opponent to 40-or-fewer-points in a game ... The Hokies had a 54-point lead in the win over UMES, the largest since a 72-point lead in the MSM game in 2011.

Lots of Options

So far this season, the Hokies have had nine players record double figures in at least one game ... One other player has scored nine points in two separate games ... Last season, Tech had eight players score in double figures at least one ... Tech has four players with at least 20 points in a game and **Justin Bibbs** scored 30 points in the win over Washington.

Working Overtime

The 83-80 overtime win at Ole Miss on Dec. 2 was Tech's first overtime game of the season ... This was the Hokies' first overtime game since defeating No. 12 Virginia, 80-78, in double overtime on Feb. 12, 2017 ... Tech is now 66-49 overall in overtime games and 6-3 in overtime games under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 30-11 in home overtime games and 16-8 in overtime in ACC games ... Tech is 28-25 in road overtime games ... The Ole Miss victory was Tech's first over an SEC school in an overtime game (Tech is now 1-2 against SEC schools in overtime).

Defense Wins

With the 63-55 win over Presbyterian, the Hokies have now won their last seven games when holding an opponent to 55-or-fewer points ... Tech is 8-1 under **Buzz Williams** in such games.

Lots of Minutes

Hokie players are among the most experienced ACC players this season ... **Justin Bibbs** has played a total of 3,406 minutes at Virginia Tech and **Devin Wilson** has played 2,996 minutes as a Hokie ... Tech has another player, **Ahmed Hill**, who has played 2,361 in just two-plus seasons at Virginia Tech ... **Justin Robinson** passed the 2,000-minute mark in the win over Iowa and **Chris Clarke** reached 1,500 minutes played during the Syracuse game.

Continuing to Climb

In the Hokies' win at Boston College last season, **Justin Bibbs** scored his 1,000th career point, becoming the 45th Hokie to reach that plateau ... He currently has 1,221 points, 31st on the list, after passing Dorenzo Hudson in the win over Presbyterian, when he scored his 1,200th career point.

Home is Where the Wins Are

With the Hokies' win over North Carolina A&T, Tech completed non-conference play 9-0 at home ... Tech was 15-2 in Cassell Coliseum all of last season ... Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 47-16 (.746) in Cassell Coliseum and is 38-7 (.844) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won 17 consecutive home non-conference games ... The nine non-conference home wins is second-best at Virginia Tech since the Hokies joined the Metro Conference in 1978.

Not Marginal at All

The 24-point winning margin against Iowa in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge marked the second time in as many games this season that Tech defeated a Power 5 conference opponent by 24 points ... Tech downed Washington, 103-79 in Madison Square Garden earlier in November ... The 24-point margin of victory is the largest ever for Tech in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.

Less Than a Third

The Hokies held Iowa to just 33.3 percent from the field on Nov. 28 ... It is the lowest field goal percentage for a Power 5 team against Tech since Nov. 27 of last year, when the Hokies held Nebraska to 29.8 percent in the Wooden Legacy in Anaheim, California ... Tech held the Cornhuskers to 19.0 percent from three-point range that game.

A Lid on the Basket

In Tech's win over UMES, the Hawks shot 27.8 percent from the field, a season low for a Tech opponent ... They shot 15.4 percent from three-point range, second-lowest of the season ... The last time the Hokies held an opponent to a lower field goal percentage in a game was on Nov. 21, 2015, when they held VMI to 25.7 percent from the field ... The last time Tech held an opponent to a lower three-point field goal percentage was on March 2, 2016, when Tech held Pittsburgh to 14.3 percent from beyond the arc.

It has Happened This Season

Justin Bibbs made his 400th career field goal in the win over Morehead State, reached the 200 made three-point field goal plateau in the win over Iowa and scored his 1,200th career point in the win over Presbyterian ... **Ahmed Hill** scored his 800th career point and **Chris Clarke** scored his 500th career point in the win over Iowa ... Clarke reached the 1,500 minutes played mark at Syracuse ... **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, grabbed his 200th career rebounds and scored his 300th career point in the win over Iowa ... **Justin Robinson** reached the 2,000 minutes played for his career plateau in the win over Iowa and the 300 assists plateau in the overtime win at Ole Miss ... **Devin Wilson** passed Zabian Dowdell into sixth place in career assists at Tech in the win over UMES.

Century Marks

The Hokies defeated Washington, 103-79, on Nov. 17 ... The 103 points is the most points Tech has scored against a current Power 5 school in a regulation game since a 109-68 victory over South Carolina on Jan. 25, 1985 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is the first time that they have achieved that feat away from Cassell Coliseum since a 106-75 win over the Gamecocks in Salem, Virginia on Dec. 22, 1960, the only other time this has occurred ... Tech scored more than 100 points in three of its first four games for the first time in school history ... Tech has scored 100-or-more points three times this season for the first time since 1988-89.

585 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 585-190 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .755 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 9-0 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

It Was a Big Week

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss of the SEC 83-80, in overtime on Dec. 2 after defeating Iowa of the Big Ten, 79-55, on Nov. 28 in Blacksburg ... This marked the first time since the 2012-13 season that Tech played back-to-back games against Power 5 competition in less than a calendar week not part of an exempt tournament ... In that season, the Hokies defeated Iowa, 95-79, in Cassell Coliseum on Nov. 27 and followed that with an 81-71 home win over No. 15 Oklahoma State ... The last time Tech played such teams in which one of the games was a road game was the 2011-12 season, when Tech lost at Minnesota, 58-55, in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge and lost at home to Kansas State, 69-61, five days later ... Tech finished the 2017-18 non-conference schedule with three wins against Power 5 competition.

Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams is 64-51 in his fourth year as the Hokies' head coach and an overall record of 217-137 record in 10-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach ... He won his 200th career game last season against Boston College on Jan. 29 in Cassell Coliseum.

Plenty of Points

In the Hokies' win over Washington, **Justin Bibbs** scored 30 points, **Ahmed Hill** scored 23 points and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** scored 20 points ... That is the first time that a Hokie scored 30 points and two teammates scored at least 20 points in a game since March 18, 2009, when A.D. Vassallo scored 33 points, Jeff Allen had 23 points, J.T. Thompson had 21 points and Malcolm Delaney scored 20 points against Duquesne in the 2009 NIT.

Outlaw to Miss Season, but Get Degree

Redshirt senior wing **Ty Outlaw** will miss the 2017-18 season following surgery for a torn ACL in his right knee ... He suffered the injury in July ... Outlaw set a Virginia Tech record when he made eight three-pointers in the home win over No. 25 Miami on Feb. 27 ... Outlaw finished his degree requirements at the end of the Fall 2017 semester and will walk at graduation in the spring.

He Earned It

Nick Fullard transferred from Division II Belmont Abbey College in North Carolina to Virginia Tech and joined the program as a walk-on ... Due to NCAA transfer rules, Fullard was forced to sit out last season ... Earlier this school year, head coach **Buzz Williams** awarded Fullard a scholarship ... Tech currently has 12 players on scholarship.

MEN'S BASKETBALL



Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad begins his fourth season in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Beginning his 11th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 217-137. Williams has compiled a 64-51 record in his fourth season in Blacksburg.

The Hokies are coming off their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned their first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive

season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an

identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

"The continued growth of our basketball program under Buzz Williams has been dramatic and noticeable on a national level," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "With the daily mantra of 'Get Better', this program has accomplished so much in his three seasons in Blacksburg. Buzz recruits and develops responsible, respectful student athletes who achieve and are successful on the court and in our community. Our future is very bright under Buzz's leadership"

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional

Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.

finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2017-18 will mark his 11th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference
