## HOKIE NOTES

### About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter the game 14-6 overall and 3-4 in ACC action ... The Fighting Irish are 13-7 overall and 3-4 in conference play.

### Last Time Out: VT 80, #10 UNC 69

The Hokies picked up a big victory on Monday night, defeating No. 10/10 North Carolina, 80-69, in Cassell Coliseum as part of ESPN's "Big Monday" ... The Hokies trailed by as many as seven points in the first half, but finished the half strong and took a 39-32 lead into the intermission ... Tech led by as many as 16 points in the second half before claiming the 80-69 win ... **Justin Robinson** scored 19 points, **Ahmed Hill** had 18 points and **Kerry Blackshear Jr.** scored 16 points to lead the Hokies ... Tech out rebounded the Tar Heels, 36-35, and committed just nine turnovers in the contest ... The Hokies allowed UNC just two points off of Virginia Tech turnovers in the game and held the Tar Heels to just four points in transition.

### The Hokies vs. Notre Dame

Virginia Tech is 1-7 all-time against the Fighting Irish, in a series that began in 1973 ... Tech is 0-3 in road games against Notre Dame ... Notre Dame has won the last seven meetings in the series ... Tech is 0-3 against ND under **Buzz Williams**.

### It Was a BIG Night

Monday night's win over the defending national champion North Carolina Tar Heels was the first of two ESPN "Big Monday" games this season for the Hokies ... The Duke game on Feb. 26 is also a Big Monday contest ... Monday's game marked the first time that the Hokies have been featured on Big Monday, either in the Big East or ACC.

### BIG Notes

The win over the 10th ranked Tar Heels was the Hokies' first win over a top 10 team since defeating No. 5 Duke, 89-75, in Cassell Coliseum on Dec. 31, 2016 ... The win snapped a seven-game losing streak in the all-time series with UNC ... This was the Hokies' first win over the Tar Heels since Feb. 4, 2010, a 74-70 Tech win in Cassell Coliseum ... This was the Hokies' first win over a defending national champion since defeating No. 1 Duke, 64-60, in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 26, 2011 ... The 11-point margin of victory was Tech's largest against the Tar Heels since a 62-48 win over UNC on Dec. 5, 1949 in War Memorial Hall.

### More on the Win against UNC

The Hokies out rebounded UNC, 36-35 ... That is the first time since March 1, 2014 that Tech has out rebounded the Tar Heels ... In last year's game against the Heels, UNC held a 43-22 advantage on the glass ... Tech's nine turnovers are the fewest against UNC since Jan. 19, 2012, when Tech committed just eight turnovers ... The Hokies held UNC to just two points off of turnovers and just four points in transition ... The last time Tech defeated a top 10 UNC team was Feb. 13, 2007, when Tech knocked off No. 4 UNC, 81-80, in overtime in the Smith Center ... Earlier that season, Tech had defeated No. 1 UNC, 94-88, in Cassell Coliseum ... This was the third time that Tech defeated a nationally-ranked UNC team in the AP poll era.

### High for 5 X2

In the loss at Louisville, **Justin Robinson** recorded a new career-high with 23 points ... In the loss to Florida State in the Hokies' next game, Robinson set a new career-high, as he scored 26 points ... He also dished out six assists and had a career-high 10 made field goals against the Seminoles ... In the next game, Robinson led the Hokies with 19 points in the win over No. 10 North Carolina.

### Hot in the New Year

Since the turn of the calendar to 2018, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.** has been on a bit of a scoring run ... In the six games played this year, Blackshear is averaging 16.7 points per game, shooting 59.3 percent from the floor ... He has made eight of his 16 three-pointers in January ... He recorded his second double-double of the season and fourth of his career with 19 points and 12 rebounds at Louisville and has scored in double figures in all six games.

### Also Hot in 2018

Joining Blackshear in a hot 2018, **Justin Robinson** has also been on a bit of a scoring run ... In the six games played this year, Robinson is averaging 17.3 points per game, shooting 55.1 percent from the floor ... He has 32 assists in the new year ... He recorded his first double-double of the season and with 11 points and 10 assists against Pitt and has scored in double figures in all six games ... He set new career highs in points in the Louisville (23 points) and Florida State (26 points) games.

### KJ Comes Through

In the Hokies' 81-67 win over Pittsburgh, redshirt sophomore **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, posted his best game as a Hokie, scoring a career-high 31 points to lead Tech ... It was his fourth game of 20-or-more points this season and first-ever of 30 or more points ... The 31 points is the first time a Hokie has scored 30-or-more points in an ACC regular season game since **Justin Bibbs** scored 32 points in a win over Wake Forest in Cassell Coliseum on Jan. 13, 2016 ... Blackshear becomes one of just seven Hokies to score 30-or-more points in an ACC regular season game ... The seven players have accomplished the feat 15 times ... The 31 points is tied for eighth in most points by a Hokie in an ACC regular season game ... The 31 points are the most points scored by a Virginia Tech player taller than 6-7 in ACC play and the most since Coleman Collins (6-9) scored 32 points at James Madison on Jan. 2, 2006 ... The 31 points is tied for the fifth-most by an ACC player this season and second-most in an ACC game this season.

### JRob is Double Good at Sharing

A major contributor to **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**'s 31 points in the win over Pitt was **Justin Robinson** ... "5" recorded a season-high 10 assists in the contest, one off his own (shared with **Devin Wilson**) school record for assists in an ACC game of 11 and two off the school overall record ... Robinson recorded 10 assists and just two turnovers in the contest and recorded his first double-double of the season and the second of his career with his 11 point, 10 assist performance.

### Sharing is Good

In the win over The Citadel, the Hokies recorded 36 assists ... That set a new school record for assists in a game, breaking the old mark of 31, set against South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982 ... In the win over Washington, the Hokies assisted on 23 of their 30 made baskets, good for 76.7 percent ... For the season, Tech has 350 assists on 593 made field goals, for 59.0 percent ... Tech has nine players with at least double figures in assists this season ... **Justin Robinson** hit the 100 assists plateau for the season at Louisville ... Tech has eight games this season of 20-or-more assists ... Tech is averaging 17.5 assists per game, up from 15.1 assists per game last season.

### Pointing This Out

Twenty games into the 2017-18 season and the Hokies are averaging 85.3 points per game ... Last season, Tech averaged 79.1 points per game ... The 85.3 ppg would be the Hokies' highest average since the 1988-89 season, when Tech averaged 87.1 points per game ... The season before, the 1987-88 season, the Hokies set a school record, averaging 91.2 points per game.

### Analytics and All

As of Jan. 26, the Hokies are ranked 48th by Kenpom.com ... Tech is third nationally in effective field goal percentage and fifth nationally in two-point percentage ... Tech is 14th in raw offensive efficiency and length of possession, 24th in three-point percentage and 28th in free throw rate ... Tech is 27th in adjusted offensive efficiency, 43rd in adjusted tempo, 45th in assist percentage and 50th in raw tempo.

### Continuing to Climb

In the Hokies' win at Boston College last season, **Justin Bibbs** scored his 1,000th career point, becoming the 45th Hokie to reach that plateau ... He currently has 1,285 points, 26th on the list, after passing Jamon Gordon and Wayne Robinson in the win over North Carolina.

### A Balancing Act

The Hokies enter tonight's game with five players averaging in double figures ... **Ahmed Hill** leads Tech scorers, averaging 14.9 points per game ... Tech has eight players averaging double figures in minutes played this season, with **Justin Bibbs** at 32.2 minutes played per game the only player averaging more than 30 minutes per game.

### Lots of Options

So far this season, the Hokies have had nine players record double figures in at least one game ... One other player has scored nine points in two separate games ... Last season, Tech had eight players score in double figures at least one ... Six different Hokies have led the team in scoring so far this season ... Tech has five players with at least 20 points in a game and **Justin Bibbs** and **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, have each scored at least 30 points in a game this season.

### Threes' Points

In the Hokies' win over Maryland-Eastern Shore, Tech made 15 three-point field goals, marking the second time this season Tech has made at least 15 threes ... So far this season, Tech individual players have made at least three, threes in a game 23 times ... **Ahmed Hill** was 11-of-15 from three-point territory in the two games in Madison Square Garden in the 2K Classic ... Hill has made at least four, three-pointers in a game six times this season and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** has made at least four, three-pointers in a game four times this season ... Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in 10 games this season, including the win over No. 10 North Carolina, when Tech made 12 three-pointers.

### Tech vs. AP Poll

The Hokies are 36-180 all-time against teams ranked in the AP poll ... The Hokies are 1-2 against ranked teams this season and were 3-6 against ranked teams last season ... With the win over No. 10 UNC, Tech is now 2-2 all-time against teams ranked 10th in the AP poll.

### Selling Out

It was announced on Friday, Jan. 19 that Tech's home game with Louisville game is now a sell out ... Tech sold out the season opener against Detroit Mercy and the game against The Citadel ... It was announced on Dec. 15 that home games against North Carolina, Duke, Florida State and Miami have all sold out.

### Hokies in National Stats

As of Jan. 26, the Hokies are third in the nation in field goal percentage, 15th in scoring offense, 19th in scoring margin and 20th in assists per game ... Tech is 25th in three-point field goal percentage and 36th in assist/turnover ratio ... Individually, **Ahmed Hill** is 16th nationally in three-point field goal percentage and **Justin Robinson** is 37th in assists per game and 45th in assists.

### Call It a Comeback

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss in Oxford on Dec. 2, 83-80, in overtime ... In doing so, the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit ... The 16-point comeback is the largest for Tech in a game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum.

### Lots of Minutes

Hokie players are among the most experienced ACC players this season ... **Justin Bibbs** has played a total of 3,611 minutes at Virginia Tech and **Devin Wilson** has played 3,062 minutes as a Hokie, passing the 3,000 minute mark in the home loss to Virginia ... Tech has another player, **Ahmed Hill**, who has played 2,543 in just two-plus seasons at Virginia Tech, eclipsing the 2,500 minute mark against Florida State ... **Justin Robinson** passed the 2,000-minute mark in the win over Iowa and **Chris Clarke** reached 1,500 minutes played during the Syracuse game.

### Home is Where the Wins Are

Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 49-18 (.731) in Cassell Coliseum and is 40-9 (.816) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won 17 consecutive home non-conference games ... The nine non-conference home wins is second-best at Virginia Tech since the Hokies joined the Metro Conference in 1978 ... Tech is 11-2 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

### Working Overtime

The 83-80 overtime win at Ole Miss on Dec. 2 was Tech's first overtime game of the season ... This was the Hokies' first overtime game since defeating No. 12 Virginia, 80-78, in double overtime on Feb. 12, 2017 ... Tech is now 66-49 overall in overtime games and 6-3 in overtime games under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 30-11 in home overtime games and 16-8 in overtime in ACC games ... Tech is 28-25 in road overtime games ... The Ole Miss victory was Tech's first over an SEC school in an overtime game (Tech is now 1-2 against SEC schools in overtime).

### Moving Up the List

**Justin Robinson** has 367 career assists at Virginia Tech ... He passed Brendan Dunlap into ninth place on the list in the win over North Carolina A&T.

### Seeing the Hokies

The attendance for the Hokies' game at Syracuse on Dec. 31, 2017 was 20,688, the second-largest crowd of the season to see the Hokies play (a crowd of 22,690 saw Tech and Kentucky play at Rupp Arena on Dec. 16) ... The Syracuse crowd was the 12th-largest to see a regular season game involving the Hokies.

### Sy Returns

**Khadim Sy** has returned to the Virginia Tech men's basketball program ... The sophomore post player from Dakar, Senegal is practicing with the team this semester, but will redshirt the 2017-18 season ... He will have three years of eligibility available beginning the Fall 2018.

### 587 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 587-192 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .754 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 11-2 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

### It has Happened This Season

**Justin Bibbs** made his 400th career field goal in the win over Morehead State, reached the 200 made three-point field goal plateau in the win over Iowa and scored his 1,200th career point in the win over Presbyterian ... **Ahmed Hill** scored his 900th career point in the win over Pitt and **Chris Clarke** scored his 500th career point in the win over Iowa ... **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, grabbed his 250th career rebounds and scored his 400th career point against Virginia ... **Justin Robinson** reached the 2,000 minutes played for his career plateau in the win over Iowa and the 300 assists plateau in the overtime win at Ole Miss ... **Devin Wilson** passed Zabian Dowdell into sixth place in career assists at Tech in the win over UMES and played his 3,000th minute at Tech in the loss to Virginia.

### Bibbs a Demon vs. Wake

**Justin Bibbs** has played seven career games against Wake Forest ... Bibbs has scored in double figures in six of the contests and started all but one of the games ... For his career, he is averaging 16.6 points per game and is shooting 53.2 percent from the floor, including 42.1 percent from three-point range ... Take away the two ACC Tournament games and Bibbs averages 18.4 points per game against the Deacs.

### Buzz Williams

**Buzz Williams** is 67-54 in his fourth year as the Hokies' head coach and an overall record of 220-140 record in 10-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach ... He won his 200th career game last season against Boston College on Jan. 29 in Cassell Coliseum.

#### That Was a Big Week

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss of the SEC 83-80, in overtime on Dec. 2 after defeating Iowa of the Big Ten, 79-55, on Nov. 28 in Blacksburg ... That marked the first time since the 2012-13 season that Tech played back-to-back games against Power 5 competition in less than a calendar week, not part of an exempt tournament ... In that season, the Hokies defeated Iowa, 95-79, in Cassell Coliseum on Nov. 27 and followed that with an 81-71 home win over No. 15 Oklahoma State ... Tech finished the 2017-18 non-conference schedule with three wins against Power 5 competition.

#### Outlaw to Miss Season, but Get Degree

Redshirt senior **Ty Outlaw** will miss the 2017-18 season following surgery for a torn ACL in his right knee, suffered in July ... Outlaw set a Virginia Tech record with eight three-pointers in the home win over No. 25 Miami last year ... Outlaw finished his degree requirements at the end last semester and will walk at graduation in the spring.

#### Century Marks

The Hokies defeated Washington, 103-79, on Nov. 17 ... The 103 points is the most points Tech has scored against a current Power 5 school in a regulation game since a 109-68 victory over South Carolina on Jan. 25, 1985 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is the first time that they have achieved that feat away from Cassell Coliseum since a 106-75 win over the Gamecocks in Salem, Virginia on Dec. 22, 1960, the only other time this has occurred.

#### Trip of a Lifetime

**Ty Outlaw** was part of a Virginia Tech Athletics trip to study in Rwanda this summer ... Outlaw enrolled in UAP 3984: Sport, Policy and Society – a study abroad course that explores different sectors of international development and how sport can support such development ... Danny White, senior associate AD for student-athlete development, oversaw the course and led a contingent that included Tech student-athletes, students, and athletics department staff members on a two-week immersion to Rwanda.

## MEN'S BASKETBALL



Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad begins his fourth season in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Beginning his 11th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 220-140. Williams has compiled a 67-54 record in his fourth season in Blacksburg.

The Hokies are coming off their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned their first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive

season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an

identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

"The continued growth of our basketball program under Buzz Williams has been dramatic and noticeable on a national level," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "With the daily mantra of 'Get Better', this program has accomplished so much in his three seasons in Blacksburg. Buzz recruits and develops responsible, respectful student athletes who achieve and are successful on the court and in our community. Our future is very bright under Buzz's leadership"

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional

finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2017-18 will mark his 11th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference

Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
