Entering the NCAA Regional

Two Hokies will compete in the 2017 NCAA West Lafayette Regional this week ... This is the second consecutive season that at least one Hokie has made the NCAA field as an individual and the 11th consecutive season that there has been a Hokie presence in the NCAA field.

The two individual competitors for the Hokies in the 2017 West Lafayette Regional rank first and second in career stroke average at Virginia Tech ... Sophomore **Mark Lawrence Jr.**, has a stroke average of 71.34 and freshman **Sarit Suwannarut** has a stroke average of 71.57 ... All five players that competed in the 2017 ACC Championship are ranked in the top 30 all-time at Virginia Tech ... Sophomore **Logan Yates** is 11th at 73.55 and senior **Joey Lane** is 16th at 74.09 ... Senior **Drew Johnson** is 28th, all-time, at 75.47 ... Associate head coach **Brian Sharp** is 17th on the list at 74.15.

About Our Competitors

Both Virginia Tech golfers competing this week, sophomore **Mark Lawrence** and freshman **Sarit Suwannarut** are making their first appearances in NCAA regional competition ... Both played in every event for the Hokies this season, although Lawrence was forced to miss the final round of the Tar Heel Invitational in the fall due to an injury ... Lawrence is in his first season with the Hokies, after transferring from Auburn during the summer.

For the Win

Sarit Suwannarut picked up a win on a professional circuit before his arrival in Blacksburg ... Last summer, he won the Singha Pattaya Open on the ASEAN PGA Tour ... He also won the 2014 Thailand Amateur.

Been Here Before, Sort of

Though this is the first visit for **Mark Lawrence** and **Sarit Suwannarut** to the Kampen Course, this is not the first time a Hokie has competed in NCAA competition on this course ... In the 2008 NCAA Championship, Tech senior Jurrian van der Vaart finished ninth individually on this course ... That was the third-best finish by a Hokie individual in NCAA Championship competition.

Been Here Before, Sort of, Part Two

This course is also by no means "new" to Virginia Tech head coach **Jay Hardwick** ... Hardwick has been an instructor at a summer golf school here since the course was redesigned by Pete Dye in 1994.

2016-17 Season – Earned a berth in NCAA West Lafayette Regional ... Playing his first season at Virginia Tech after transferring from Auburn ... Was a member of the starting lineup for every event this season ... Leads the team in scoring with a 71.34 average and in “Crunch Time” scoring with a 71.00 final round average ... Has posted 19 rounds at par-or-better ... Finished fifth at the Joe Feaganes Marshall Invitational ... 24th at the Janney Invitational ... Had his best showing with a fourth place finish at the General Hackler Championship, followed that with a fifth place finish at Furman and then finished 10th at Augusta ... Had a 16th place finish at NC State ... Finished 27th at the 2017 ACC Men’s Golf Championship ... Won the team’s “Crunch Time” award and was the team’s co-Player of the Year.

Junior Golf/High School – Four-year letter winner in golf at Mills Godwin for coach Tom Hoy ... Lawrence was the VHSL Individual State Champion in 2011, 2013 and 2014 and led Godwin to the VHSL team title in 2012 and 2014 ... He was the All-Metro player of the year in 2011, 2013 and 2014 ... Four-year All State, Region and District selection at Godwin ... He was the 2015 Mills Godwin Athlete of the Year and won the Student Athlete Achievement Award presented by the Virginia Sports Hall of Fame in 2014 ... VSGA Junior Boys Golfer of the Year for 2013, 2014 and 2015 ... Lawrence won the Virginia State Junior Match Play Championship three consecutive years, 2013, 2014 and 2015, joining former Hokie golfer Mikey Moyers as the only golfers to win the Virginia State Junior Match Play title in three consecutive years ... He was the runner-up to Virginia Tech’s Maclain Huge in the 2015 Virginia State Amateur and won the 2015 Virginia State Junior Stroke Play Championship ... Lawrence won the 2013 Mid-Atlantic Amateur Championship.

Led the team in scoring during the fall with a 69.92 average, including 11 of 13 rounds at par-or-better ... Shot 64 in his first-ever collegiate round at the Joe Feaganes Marshall Invitational, tying the Virginia Tech individual scoring record, en route to a third place finish ... Finished third at the Janney Invitational ... 13th at the Tarheel Intercollegiate and 15th at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate ... Currently second in scoring at 71.57 ... Finished 13th at the Wolfpack Spring open.

Amateur – Won the 2016 ASEAN PGA Tour Singha Pattaya Open ... Was the No. 1 ranked amateur in Thailand and Southeast Asia at the end of the 2014 season ... 2014 Thailand Amateur Open champion.

Junior Golf/High School – Competed in the 2015 USGA Junior Amateur in Bluffton, S.C., finishing fifth in stroke play qualifying and advancing to match play ... Member of the Thailand National team that won the gold medal in the 2015 SEA Games in Singapore.

Commonwealth's Finest

Hokie senior **Joey Lane** defeated Ji Soo Park to win the 103rd Virginia State Golf Association's State Amateur on July 2, 2016 at the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... Lane became the fifth Hokie golfer to claim the championship and the second consecutive ... Former teammate Maclain Huge won the event the year before, defeating current Hokie **Mark Lawrence Jr.**, in the finals in Charlottesville ... Lawrence advanced to the semifinals in 2016, when he lost to Lane, 2 & 1 ... Lane also won the Eastern Amateur the following week ... Lawrence rounded out the summer being the low amateur at the State Open of Virginia and lost in a championship playoff for the title ... This summer, Lawrence will be looking to add the State Amateur title to his resume and join his father, Mark Sr., on the list ... The elder Lawrence won the 1980 State Amateur.

New Faces Next Year

During the early signing period in November, Virginia Tech announced that Connor Burgess of Lynchburg, Virginia, had signed a national letter of intent to attend Virginia Tech and play golf for the Hokies in Fall 2017 ... This spring, the Hokies added international standout Slade Pickering of South Africa to the Fall 2017 class.

Jay's the Only One

When the Hokies tied Georgia Tech for the 2007 ACC Men's Golf Championship, Virginia Tech head coach **Jay Hardwick** became the only coach in NCAA history to win conference titles in four different Division I athletic conferences ... Prior to winning the ACC, Hardwick had led the Hokies to conference titles in the Metro, Atlantic 10 and Big East Conferences.

Too "Sharp" of a Coach

Of the 16 players ranked ahead of Associate Head Coach **Brian Sharp** on the Virginia Tech all-time scoring list, 14 have been coached by Sharp ... Only current PGA Tour competitors Brendon de Jonge and Johnson Wagner were not coached by Sharp ... Sharp was the all-time leading scorer in Virginia Tech history when he graduated in 1995 ... Sharp was inducted into the Virginia Tech Sports Hall of Fame in 2009.

Sparkling New Digs

At the beginning of the Spring 2017 semester, the Virginia Tech men's and women's golf teams opened the new indoor practice facility, located in Cassell Coliseum ... The 2,600-square foot facility includes offices for the coaches, locker space for the teams, a large meeting room, a putting and chip area and two state-of-the-art golf simulators ... Total cost of the project was approximately \$600,000, and all money was in place through private donations as construction began ... This facility allows more practice and instruction during winter months and inclement weather ... The location of the facility also is advantageous in its proximity to nutrition, sports medicine, strength and conditioning and student academic support.

Hokies on the PGA Tour

A pair of Hokies are currently competing on the PGA Tour ... Johnson Wagner won his first-ever PGA Tour event at the Houston Shell Open in 2008, earning him a berth the next week at the 2008 Masters Tournament ... He won the 2011 Mayakoba Golf Classic in El Camaleon, Riviera Maya, Mexico on the PGA Tour and won the Sony Open in Hawaii in January, 2012, which helped him to claim PGA Tour Player of the Month for January 2012 ... Former teammate Brendon de Jonge was the 2008 Nationwide Tour Player of the Year, finishing second on the money list, earning his return to the PGA Tour in 2009 ... He also played on the PGA Tour in 2007 ... de Jonge was a captain's selection for the International team in the 2013 President's Cup and was teamed with Ernie Els ... de Jonge has a provisional PGA Tour card this season.

Athletics Success

Virginia Tech's athletics program has made quite a splash in the ACC since joining the league in 2004 ... The Hokie football team won the 2004 ACC Championship and played in the inaugural ACC Football Championship game after winning the Coastal Division title, winning the conference title in 2007, 2008 and 2010 ... Former football coach Frank Beamer was twice named the ACC Coach of the Year ... The men's soccer team advanced to the College Cup in 2007 and the softball team appeared in NCAA Women's College World Series in 2008 ... The women's soccer program advanced to the College Cup in the fall of 2013 ... The men's and women's track & field programs have won 14 NCAA titles by five athletes since 2005 ... Queen Harrison appeared in the 2008 Olympics in Beijing and won the 60-meter hurdle championship at the 2010 NCAA Indoor Championship and became the first woman ever to win both the 400m and 100m hurdle titles at the 2010 NCAA Outdoor Championship ... The wrestling team has recorded top 10 national finishes in each of the last five seasons.

A Course to Dye For

Virginia Tech's commitment to golf became more evident 13 years ago, when it was announced that famed golf course architect Pete Dye would lead the renovation of the River Course of Virginia Tech ... The project, which began on Jan. 5, 2004, was completed in 2006 ... A \$5.5 million clubhouse was completed in 2010 ... Upon completion, the course became a Pete Dye Signature Course and was rechristened as the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... In addition to the upgraded course, a team facility boasts an indoor teaching center, locker rooms and team meeting room for the Virginia Tech men's and women's golf teams ... These improvements were made possible by support from Bill and Alice Goodwin of Richmond, Virginia ... As part of the project, Tech's artificial practice tee was covered and equipped with radiant heaters ... The indoor facility was constructed adjacent to the newly-dedicated golf team practice area, which was made possible through the generosity of long-time golf supporter and scholarship donor, the late C.M. "Buddy" Neviasser.

Virginia Tech hosted the 2011 NCAA East Regional Golf Championship at the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech ... This was the first NCAA event hosted on the course ... Tech hosted the 1997 NCAA East Regional and the 2004 NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championship at the Homestead Resort in Hot Springs, Va. ... This past summer, the River Course hosted the Virginia State Amateur Championship, won by current Hokie **Joey Lane** ... Teammate **Mark Lawrence Jr.**, was a semifinalist.

NCAA Golf Odds & Ends

Lawrence and Suwannarut are two of three ACC golfers competing in West Lafayette ... Keegan de Lange of Louisville also is in the individual field ... The Kampen Course was designed by renowned golf course designer Pete Dye, who also redesigned the Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech, the home course of the Hokies

Virginia Tech men's golf received Public Recognition Awards from the NCAA for top academic scores in the classroom, as announced by the NCAA ... Public Recognition Awards get handed out based on a sport's multi-year Academic Progress Rate, better known as APR ... The APR is an annual scorecard of academic achievement calculated for all Division I sports teams nationally ... To receive a Public Recognition Award, a team must have an APR in the top 10 percent of its sport ... This is the eighth consecutive year the Hokies have received the honor.

Hardwick is also the Director of Golf at Virginia Tech and oversaw the incorporation of The Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech, into the Virginia Tech operation, as well as the construction of team facilities at the course ... Hardwick was inducted into the GCAA's Hall of Fame in 2008 and was the inaugural winner in 2005 of the Labron Harris Jr. Award, given by the PGA of America ...
