LAST SEASON...

- The Hokies went 5-9-3 overall and 0-5-3 in the ACC last year.
- Tech had a big upset over #10 Xavier and tied #19 Louisville and #7 Notre Dame. The squad did not make the postseason after finishing fifth in the Coastal ACC ranks.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE..

- In all, ten teams that made the 2015 NCAA postseason appear on Tech's schedule: Oakland, Charlotte, South Florida, Virginia, Ohio State, North Carolina, Georgetown, Notre Dame, Syracuse and Clemson.

EIGHT YEARS OF BRIZ..

- Head coach Mike Brizendine will enter his eighth season in 2016. He has led Tech to a 42-81-21 record in the last seven seasons. With 11 years of head coaching experience, veteran Briz continues to inspire the Hokies.

FRESH FACE

-The Hokies add 12 new faces to the team...10 freshman and three transfers. The transfers hail from Patrick Henry Community College, Hosuton Baptist and Greensboro College.

NEVER MUCH LOVE WHEN WE GO OT..

- During the 2015 season, Tech went into overtime four times. The Hokies struggled to win during those occasions, tying three times in double OT and losing once in OT.

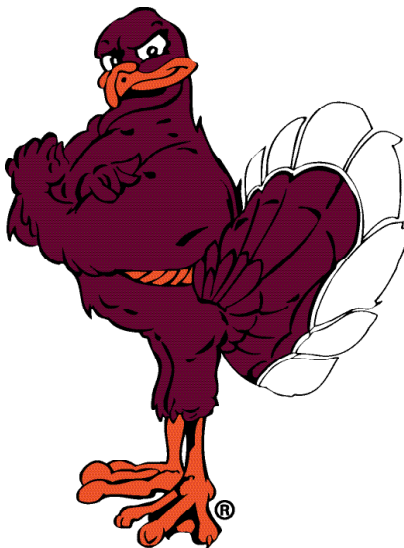

WHAT IS A HOKIE?



That's the most often-asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics. The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body. Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today.

Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention. Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.
