- Virginia Tech is now undefeated for the first three games of the season since 2006
- Tech just missed the NSCAA Top 25 but still receiving votes
- Acuna leads the team in points with 8
- Virginia Tech upset #18 Ohio State on Aug. 26 in double overtime. Acuna found the back of the net off a header in the 107th minute.
- Hokies advanced to 2-0-0 on the season after a 3-0 shutout against Oakland on Aug. 28. Three Hokies scored (Acuna, Tamburini and Thomas).
- Acuna and Lundgaard were named the ACC Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week
- Acuna was choose as VT's Athlete of the Week.
- Acuna was named HERO of the Week by HERO Sports

GEORGETOWN..

- #24 Hoyas were on the road Friday at #7 Maryland
- Georgetown lost in the last minute of play as the teams were tied 1-1 until the 90th minute
- A Terrapin was taken down in the box and awarded a PK
- Hoya GK made the stop but Maryland grabbed the deflection for a game winning goal
- The Hoys have had trouble this 2016 season, losing to now Maryland, West Virginia and Akron
- Their home opener will be Labor Day as they spent the first three games on the road

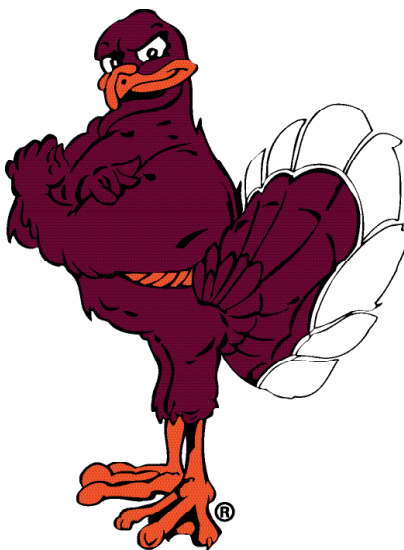

WHAT IS A HOKIE?

That's the most often-asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics. The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body. Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today.

Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention. Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.
