Emergency Equipment: supplies (AED, Trauma kit, splint kit, and spine board) maintained in Hallway off Main Floor. Additional equipment located in the Eddie Ferrell athletic training facility located on the 1st floor of Jamerson adjacent to Cassell Coliseum.

Roles of First Responders

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Emergency equipment retrieval
3. Activation of emergency medical system (EMS)
 - 911 call (provide name, address, telephone number; number of individuals injured; condition of injured; first aid treatment; specific directions; other information as requested)
 - Notify campus police at 231-6411
4. Direction of EMS to scene
 - Open appropriate gates
 - Designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to scene
 - Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area.

Venue Directions: Cassell Coliseum is located on the corner of Washington Street and Spring Road. Emergency entrance is located off of Spring Road side entrance.

Driving Directions:

1. Off Campus:
 - Progress Street (most direct route): Take Left onto Church St., then take Right onto Roanoke St., turn Left onto Main St. and Right onto Washington St. and left onto Spring Rd. Cassell Coliseum is located on your left.
2. On Campus:
 - Take Drill field circle until you come to West Campus Dr. turn left. Go straight until you come to Washington St. turn left. Turn right onto Spring Road. Cassell Coliseum is located on your left.

Position where personal will meet emergency help:

- One person will be at the parking lot entrance on the corner of Spring Rd.
- One person will be at the street entrance off of Spring Road.
