THE HOKIES

Virginia Tech defeated Elon 68-59 to open the 2016 WNIT on Thursday night. Rachel Camp led a quartet of Hokies in double-digits with a season-high 29 points. Sidney Cook added 12 points and grabbed nine rebounds while Hannah Young tallied 11 points. Regan Magarity chipped in 10 points and nine boards. Chanette Hicks notched eight assists, seven rebounds and five steals.

Camp's 29 in the game is the second highest point tally in a postseason game for the Hokies. Ieva Kublina dropped in 32 in the WNIT against Houston on March 23, 2002. With the win, the Hokies improved to 18 wins on the season, marking the most since 2006-07 when Tech claimed 19 victories. The last time Virginia Tech made postseason was also in 2006-07 when assistant coach Britney Anderson was a senior on the team. She led the Hokies with a career-high 24 points in a third round 81-73 loss to Auburn. Tech defeated Western Carolina 74-64 in the second round after receiving a first round bye.

Hannah Young and Cook lead the Hokies, averaging 10.3 points per game. Vanessa Panousis is adding 8.7 ppg while Hicks is tallying 8.6 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.16 assists and 2.87 steals per game. Regan Magarity and Cook lead on the boards with 5.6 rpg.

THE BOBCATS

Ohio picked up the 76-68 win over Marshall in the opening round of the WNIT on Thursday night. Kiyanna Black notched 32 points, including eight 3-pointers, and pulled down seven rebounds for the Bobcats. Kelly Karlis came off the bench for 13 points and eight boards. Quiera Lampkins handed out six assists and tallied four steals.

The Bobcats are making their first appearance in the WNIT this season. Ohio has made three trips to the NCAA Tournament previously. This game marked Ohio's first win in a postseason tournament. Ohio won the East Division of the MAC this year and was the top seed in the conference tournament, but fell to 8-seed Buffalo who went on to win the title. The Bobcats were the automatic qualifier from the MAC.

Black leads Ohio with 18.6 ppg. She leads the NCAA in 3-pointers per game, averaging 3.97 and has tallied a NCAA-high 123 long-range baskets this season. Lampkins is adding 14.2 ppg, has a team-high 77 steals and 118 assists on the season. Jasmine Weatherspoon leads the Bobcats on the boards with 6.5 rpg.

THE SERIES

This marks the fifth meeting between the two teams with Ohio holding a 3-1 advantage in the series, but they have not faced each other in over 20 years.

The last time Tech and Ohio met was Nov. 28, 1994 when the Bobcats claimed a 67-66 overtime win over the Hokies. Former Tech player Jenny Root led the Hokies with 20 points.

Tech last faced a team from the MAC in 2005 when the Hokies defeated Western Michigan 69-65. The Hokies are 6-3 versus the MAC.

NOTEWORTHY

3-POINTER RECORD

Hannah Young set the new senior year record for 3-pointers made after dropping in three against Elon. She broke the old record of 70 set by Jeni Garber in 1990-91.

ROOKIE ALL-STAR

Chanette Hicks has had a big freshman season, setting four new program records. Hicks has set the new marks for single-season steals, steals in an ACC season, freshman class steals and freshman class assists. Hicks set the new single-season steals record and the assist record versus Elon. The single-season steals record was set in 1998-99 by Lisa Witherspoon with 86. The freshman class assist record was set by Hicks' teammate Vanessa Panousis with 121 in 2013-14. She broke the ACC season record and freshman class steals records during conference play.

POSTSEASON BOUND

Virginia Tech earned a 2016 WNIT At-Large bid, marking the Hokies' fourth trip to the WNIT and the 13th time making postseason since the program's first trip in 1994.

MAKE THAT TWO

The Hokies defeated Virginia on Feb. 28 for their second win over the Cavaliers this season. It marks the first time in program history that Tech has beaten UVA twice in the same season and just the third time the Hokies have won in consecutive meetings.

WINNING WAYS

The win over Wake Forest guaranteed the Hokies their first winning season since 2006-07.

RECORDS ALL AROUND

Taijah Campbell has moved into fifth place on the Tech all-time record list for career blocks. In addition, Campbell is the all-time leading rebounder vs. ACC opponents in program history, becoming the first player to have 300+ rebounds against league foes.

MOVIN' ON UP

With four 3-pointers at North Carolina, **Vanessa Panousis** moved into second place on the career record list, in addition Panousis set the program record for 3-pointers made in ACC games. She surpassed Lindsay Biggs on both lists. Biggs tallied 188 career 3s and 84 in ACC play.

RIVALRY GAME

Virginia Tech picked up its first win since 2007 over rival Virginia, defeating the Cavaliers 66-46 on Sunday, Feb. 7, 2016. It snapped UVA's 18-game win streak in the series.

CAREER GAME

Sidney Cook turned in a 23 point, 14 rebound performance in the win over Virginia. It marks one of the best performances in the Hokies' history with UVA. Former Tech players Tere Williams and Uju Ugoka tallied 21 points/10 rebounds in 1998 and 2014, respectively.

JOINING THE CLUB

Vanessa Panousis became the 24th member of the Virginia Tech 1,000-point club when she hit a 3-pointer in the third quarter at Florida State. Panousis became just the ninth player in Tech history to reach the milestone as a junior.

FRESHMAN RECORD

Chanette Hicks scooped up five steals versus Florida State to set a new freshman class record, breaking the previous record of 57 set by Sonya Dalton (1979-80) and Ieva Kublina (2000-01).

3Q SCORING

The Hokies dropped in 28 points in the third quarter vs. Clemson on Jan. 18, marking the second most points scored by the Hokies in any quarter on the year.

STRONG START

The Hokies went 13-1 to open the season, marking one of the best starts in program history. In addition, Tech's 11-game win streak marked the third longest in history. The longest streak is 18 games (1998-99) with the second at 12 straight (2003-04, 2005-06).

D-FENCE

The 33 points scored by Boston College on Jan. 3, 2016 ties the fewest points allowed in an ACC game. Tech also held Clemson to 33 points on Jan. 2, 2012.

GIMME THE BALL

Virginia Tech scooped up 16 steals in the game against Boston College, marking the first time since Jan. 2, 2012 that the Hokies have recorded 15 or more steals in a game.

DEFENSIVE STOP

The Hokies held Furman to 30 pts on Dec. 30, 2015, setting a program record for fewest points allowed.

DECEMBER TRIUMPH

The Hokies went undefeated in the month of December, marking the first time since the 2005-06 season that Tech had an unblemished record in Dec.

YOUNG FROM OUTSIDE

Hannah Young had six 3-pointers vs. Coppin State, connecting on 6-of-9 to tie the Cassell Coliseum record. In addition, Young scored a career-high 23 points to lead the Hokies to the win.

THE DIFFERENCE IS...

Tech's 40-point (73-33) win over Morgan State is the first time the Hokies have defeated a team by 40 or more points since an 82-33 decision on Dec. 21, 2013.

HONORED

Vanessa Panousis was named the espnW National Player of the Week as well as the ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 7 for her performances in Tech's wins over Penn State and Tennessee. Panousis led the Hokies in both games, tallying 16 points vs. the Lady Lions and 21 against the Lady Vols. Showing poise at the line, Panousis combined for 10-of-10 at the line

in the final minutes of the two games to help secure wins for Tech. She also dropped in five 3-pointers against Tennessee, including three in the second half to help spark the Tech offense.

Virginia Tech was also named the NCAA Team of the Week following the two wins.

NOTEWORTHY (CONT.)

WE GOT VOTES

The Hokies received votes in the Coaches' Poll this season (Dec. 9-Jan. 27). Tech also received votes in the AP Poll Dec. 7-Jan. 3. The last time Tech received votes in the AP Poll was the 2007 preseason edition.

STREAK SNAPPED

Virginia Tech's win over Tennessee on Dec. 6 snapped the Lady Vols' 44-game unbeaten streak at home against unranked opponents. In addition, Tennessee's 43 points marked the fewest UT has ever scored in a game.

A FEW FIRSTS

The Hokies win over then-No. 8 Tennessee was the first win over a top-10 team since Tech knocked off then-No. 8 Maryland in 2012. It was also the program's first win over the Lady Vols.

BACK-TO-BACK

With the wins over Penn State and Tennessee, the Hokies picked up their first back-to-back wins over non-conference Power 5 opponents since early in the 2003-04 campaign.

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

The Hokies knocked off Penn State 64-58 in the 2015 Big Ten/ACC Challenge. Tech's last win in the challenge came in 2012 over Wisconsin at home. It also marks the first time that the Hokies have won on the road as part of the challenge.

I'LL TAKE THAT

Chanette Hicks recorded six steals against Wofford, marking the most steals by a Tech player in a game since the 2011 season. Hicks also had five steals earlier in the season vs. Mason, marking the first time a player had five steals in a game since 2011.

HISTORY MAKING

Vanessa Panousis tallied six three-pointers while **Hannah Young** added five against Mason to mark the first time in program history that two players have hit five or more treys in the same game.

ON FIRE

The Hokies connected on 14-of-27 from outside the arc, shooting 51.9 percent against George Mason to

set a new team single-game three-pointers made record.

RULER OF THE CASSELL

The Hokies' **Vanessa Panousis** tallied six three-pointers in the win over George Mason, tying a Cassell Coliseum record. The mark is also the third highest single-game total in Tech history.

TOURNAMENT HONORS

Vanessa Panousis was named to the ACC All-Tournament Second Team last year becoming the first Hokie to earn ACC Tournament honors.

WELCOME TO THE HOKIES

The Hokies add a top-20 recruiting class to the ranks this year as five-star recruit **Kelly Koshuta**, four-star recruit **Chanette Hicks** and three-star recruit **Alana Gilmer** have joined the squad. All three players were nominated for the McDonald's All-American game.

WE'RE BACK

The Hokies return 10 players from last season's team that went on a memorable run in the ACC Tournament, defeating NC State in the opening round before moving on to knock off Pitt in the second round. Tech advanced to the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament for the first time in program history before falling to eventual Elite Eight team Florida State. The Hokies became the first last seeded team in the ACC to ever win multiple games in the tournament.

AROUND THE WORLD

Samantha Hill and **Vanessa Panousis** competed over the summer in the World University Games. Panousis represented Australia at the event while Hill helped team Canada to the silver medal.

FAMILY TIES

Redshirt freshman **Regan Magarity** has strong basketball ties as the daughter of Bill and Ammi Magarity. Her father played basketball at the University of Georgia and was a member of the New York Nets in the ABA before moving to Europe to play professionally for 20 years while her mother played for the Swedish National Team. Her brother

transferred to Davidson over the summer and will sit out this season due to NCAA transfer rules. In addition, Magarity has plenty of coaches in her family: David (uncle) head women's basketball coach at Army, Maureen (cousin) head women's basketball coach at New Hampshire, Mark (uncle) head volleyball coach at Philadelphia and Dan Earl (brother-in-law) head men's basketball coach at VMI.

SOME NEW FACES

The Hokies added **Heather Vulin** to the coaching staff during the offseason. Vulin comes to Tech after spending seven years at Villanova, where she served as the recruiting coordinator. Also new to the staff this season is **Bill Dooley** as an assistant coach, coming to Tech from the men's basketball ranks. Dooley spent the past three seasons on the staff at Hartford. **Nicole Krusen** comes on board as video coordinator. Krusen played last season at the National University Ireland Galway after spending four seasons as a letterwinner at Loyola Maryland.

AND A COUPLE OF FAMILIAR ONES

Former Tech players **Britney Anderson** and **Kelsey (Conyers) Shaughnessy** have returned to Blacksburg as part of the women's basketball staff. Anderson returns as an assistant coach after spending the past two seasons in the same role at Radford. Shaughnessy graduated in May and is back after being named the Director of Student-Athlete Development.

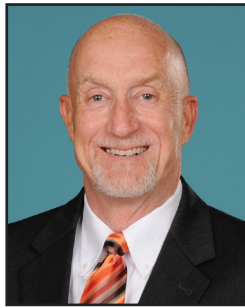

DENNIS WOLFF

Head Coach • Fifth Season
Connecticut, 1978

Dennis Wolff was named the sixth head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 22, 2011.

In 2015, the Hokies went on a historic run in the ACC Tournament, advancing to the quarterfinal round for the first time since joining

the league 10 years ago. Tech knocked off NC State in the opening round, picking up the Hokies first win over the Wolfpack in program history and recording their first post-season win since 2006-07. In the second round, the Hokies defeated Pittsburgh before falling to 2015 NCAA Elite Eight team, Florida State in the quarters. Sophomore Vanessa Panousis was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 16 points en route to setting the Virginia Tech single-season three-pointers made record.

The Hokies continued to improve under Wolff during his third year at the helm. Finishing 14-16 overall, Tech recorded its best finish since the 2009-10 season. The Hokies also boasted a win over then-ranked No. 11 North Carolina on the road, marking the programs first win in Chapel Hill. In addition, the Hokies defeated NCAA teams Florida, Michigan State and Robert Morris. Wolff also coached Uju Ugoka to All-ACC Second Team honors in 2014.

During Wolff's second season, the Hokies picked up a big win over a top-25 opponent, defeating then-19th ranked Florida State with a decisive 71-52 win over the Seminoles in Cassell Coliseum. The win snapped an eight game skid against FSU. Tech also improved in its overall and ACC record under Wolff's leadership.

In his inaugural season with the Hokies, Wolff guided Virginia Tech to an improved ACC record that featured a milestone win over then-ranked No. 8 Maryland. Tech's win over the 2012 ACC Champion Terrapins marked the first time in over a decade that the Hokies have defeated a team ranked eighth or better and just the third time in team history. Wolff was also inducted into the Basketball Old Timers of America Hall of Fame.

Prior to accepting the women's head coaching position, Wolff served one season as the Director of Men's Basketball Operations & Assistant to the Head Coach for the Virginia Tech men's basketball program. He assisted head coach Seth Greenberg in the day-to-day operations of the basketball program and also took on additional duties to better reflect a change in NCAA rules governing the operations position.

Before coming to Virginia Tech, Wolff served as the head men's basketball coach at Boston University from 1994-2009. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history. He was a three-time America East Coach of the Year and a two-time NABC District 1 Coach of the Year selection.

Wolff was 247-197 (.556) in 15 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980s, Wolff is 277-215 (.563) in 17 years as a head coach.

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach at Wake Forest and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach. In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure. In the last year, Wolff has been involved in the USO Operation Hardwood in Iraq and the USO Operation Hoop Talk in Afghanistan.

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. A native of New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn have three children: Nicole, Matt, and Michael.
