THE HOKIES

Virginia Tech moved to 15-0 the season after defeating Clemson, 78-69, on the road. Chanette Hicks and Samantha Hill each had 16 points to lead the Hokies while Hicks also tallied four assists and three steals. Regan Magarity recorded her third consecutive double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds. Sidney Cook added 13 points and eight boards.

The Hokies and Tigers kept it close to open the game and were tied at 9-9 in the first quarter before Tech went on a 10-0 run to push the lead. Clemson cut it two, but the Hokies again went on a run, outscoring the Tigers 14-4 to open the second frame. The Tigers got it under single-digits before halftime, but Tech led 39-32 at the break. Coming back out in the third, the Hokies again took the lead, going up by 16 midway through the frame and were up by 12 at the end of the quarter. Clemson looked to make a run in the final minutes, cutting it to six, but the Hokies went 5-of-6 from the line to help seal the win.

Hicks leads the Hokies, averaging 16.3 points, 5.5 assists and 4.7 steals per game. Cook is posting 14.5 ppg and 9.7 rpg. Magarity is averaging 13.5 ppg and 9.8 rebounds per game while Hill is adding 10.5 ppg. Vanessa Panousis it chipping in 10.0 ppg.

Virginia Tech is currently one of three teams in the NCAA unbeaten along with UConn and Mississippi State.

THE HURRICANES

Miami fell to No. 7/6 Notre Dame 67-55 at home on Sunday afternoon. Jessica Thomas led the Hurricanes with 15 points while Adrienne Motley chipped in 14. Emese Hof came off the bench for 11 points and a team-best six rebounds.

Miami trailed the Irish by just one at the break as Notre Dame held the 30-29 lead. The third quarter proved crucial for the Irish as they outscored the Hurricanes 21-15 in the frame. Notre Dame held the advantage in the final quarter as well 16-11. The Irish shot 51.7 percent from the field in the second half while holding Miami to 34.5 percent.

Motley leads the Canes with 12.7 ppg with Thomas adding 12.6 ppg. Keyona Hayes is pulling down a team-high 6.4 rpg and adding 8.5 ppg.

THE SERIES

This marks the 23rd meeting between the Hokies and Hurricanes with Miami holding a 16-6 advantage in the series. Miami won the most recent meeting in Coral Gables last season 67-56 in overtime.

NOTEWORTHY

HOT START

The Hokies have opened the season 15-0, marking the program's second best start. The best start was an 18-0 clip in 1998-99.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Sidney Cook ranks 18th in the NCAA with eight double-doubles on the season. The Tech senior is averaging 14.5 points and 9.7 rebounds per game. Regan Magarity is 32nd with seven double-doubles, averaging 13.5 ppg and 9.8 rpg.

SHOOTING FROM THE FIELD

Currently the Hokies have three players ranked in the nation in field goal percentage: Regan Magarity (35th, .548), Sidney Cook (76th, .497) and Chanette Hicks (146th, .454) The trio is a combined 249-of-502 from the field this season and is averaging over half the Hokies points per game at a combined 44.3 ppg.

PICKING POCKETS

Chanette Hicks ranks second in the NCAA in total steals and in steals per game.

HOKIES FOR THREE!

Out of 10 Tech players who have appeared for the Hokies this season, eight of them have connected on baskets from outside the arc. Vanessa Panousis leads the group with 36 treys. Kendyl Brooks has 24 and Sami Hill has 22.

SECOND HALF DOMINANCE

The Hokies have outscored their opponents 594-437 (+157 pts) after halftime this season. First Half: 543-423 (+120).

DOUBLE-DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Three Hokies recorded double-doubles in the game against North Carolina. Regan Magarity had 24 points, 17 rebounds; Sidney Cook tallied 16 points, 13 rebounds; while Chanette Hicks had 10 points, 10 assists. It is just the third time in program history the feat has been achieved. The last time three Tech players had double-doubles in a game was 2010 with Monet Tellier (14 pts, 10 rebs), Alyssa Fenyn (10 pts, 10 rebs) and Nikki Davis (16 pts, 12 rebs) against William & Mary.

MAGARITY'S MARK

Regan Magarity tallied 24 points and 17 rebounds against North Carolina, marking the 20th time in program history that a player has eclipsed 20+/15+. It is also just the second time it has happend versus an ACC opponent. Kerri Gardin had 22 points, 16 rebounds versus FSU in 2005.

FIERY FIRST HALF

Virginia Tech scored 52 points in the first half against Delaware State, marking the most points scored in the opening 20 minutes since the Hokies dropped in 53 versus High Point in 2007.

NON-CONFERENCE DOMINANCE

The Hokies went undefeated in the nonconference for just the fourth time in program history. The other seasons Tech went undefeated in the non-conference were 2005-06, 2003-04 and 1998-99.

RECORD WORTHY

With 13 assists at Auburn Chanette Hicks tied the Tech single-game assist record. Lisa Witherspoon hit the mark twice in 1999 while Lisa Leftwich set the record in 1992.

BACK-TO-BACK

With 92 points scored against Auburn, it is just third time in program history the Hokies have scored 90+ in back-to-back games. Tech tallied 98 vs. BGSU in Athletic Trainer: Erin Cash the previous game.

SUPER SIX

Six Hokies hit double-digits against Bowling Green on Dec. 11. It was the first time six players had more than 10 points in a game since Howard on Nov. 9, 2013.

ALL THE POINTS

The 98 points the Hokies scored against Bowling Green marked the most by the program since dropping in 103 against High Point to open the 2007-08 season.

QUALITY QUINTET

Five players scored in double-digits for the Hokies against Gardner-Webb, marking the first time in two seasons (Wake Forest, Jan. 23, 2015) that five players have scored 10+ in the same game.

WE'RE BACK

Virginia Tech cracked into the Top-25 for the first time in over a decade on Dec. 5. The last time the Hokies were ranked was Jan. 23, 2006 at 25th.

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

The Hokies defeated Nebraska on Dec. 1, to pick up a win in the 2016 ACC/BigTen Challenge. Tech helped the ACC retain the crown and won their second straight challenge contest, marking the first time in program history the Hokies have won back-to-back games in the challenge.

ON THE LIST

The Hokies win over #17/16 Tennessee was not only a noteworthy win for the program, but for head coach Kenny Brooks as well, marking the third best win over a ranked opponent:

HONORED

Chanette Hicks was named the espnW National Player of the Week as well as ACC co-Player of the Week after leading the Hokies to wins over College of Charleston and #17/16 Tennessee. Hicks averaged 23.0 ppg, connecting on 48.4 percent from the field. She also tallied 14 steals, including eight against the Lady Vols.

PANOUSIS FOR THREE!

Senior Vanessa Panousis became the Virginia Tech all-time career leader in 3-pointers made on Nov. 16 against Presbyterian with her long distance shot made with 6:05 to go in the game. She moved into the top spot, eclipsing Carrie Mason who tallied 200 treys in 2002-06.

OFF TO A GOOD START

The Hokies opened the Kenny Brooks coaching era with a 71-52 win over UNC Asheville on Nov. 11.

STARTING SUCCESS

Virginia Tech improved to a season opening record of 40-10 all-time including a 21-4 tally at home.

RETURNING FOR 16-17

The Hokies return three starters from last season's team that finished with an 18-14 overall record and helped the program to its first postseason appearance in nine years as Tech received an atlarge bid to the WNIT. Last year also marked the first winning season for the Hokies since 2006-07.

WELCOME TO BLACKSBURG

Kenny Brooks takes the helm of the Virginia Tech women's basketball team this season. Brooks compiled a 337-122 (.756) record during 14 seasons at James Madison, guiding the Dukes to 11 consecutive postseason appearances including six NCAA bids and five trips to the WNIT. Over 11 seasons at JMU, Brooks' squads never won fewer than 24 games, averaging 26.3 wins per year over that span.

MEMBER OF THE CLUB

Senior Vanessa Panousis hit the 1,000 point mark last year becoming the 24th member of the 1,000-point club and just the ninth player to do so as a junior. In addition, Panousis set the Virginia Tech career record for 3-pointers made in ACC games.

SUPER SOPH

Sophomore **Chanette Hicks** had a big freshman season, setting four new program records. Hicks set the new marks for single-season steals overall, steals in an ACC season, freshman class steals and freshman class assists. Hicks set the new singleseason steals record and the assist record during the opening round WNIT game versus Elon. She broke the previous record that was set in 1998-99 by Lisa Witherspoon with 86. The freshman class assist record was set by Hicks' teammate Vanessa Panousis with 121 in 2013-14. She broke the ACC season record and freshman class steals records during conference play.

SID THE KID

Senior **Sidney Cook** led the Hokies in scoring and rebounds last season. She averaged 10.7 points per game and upped her average to 11.7 in ACC games. Cook posted 5.8 rebounds per game and led the Hokies in scoring in a 11 games and rebound in 10.

Kenny Brooks was named the seventh head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 28, 2016.

Brooks joined the Hokies after an impressive 14-season stint as head coach es Madison University where he compiled a record of 337-122 (.756), making him the winningest in that school's history. Brooks guided the Dukes to 11 consecutive postseason appearances, ng six NCAA bids and five trips to the WNIT. Under his direction in 2015-16, JMU compiled a 27-6 including a 17-1 mark in conference play, as the Dukes made a third straight trip to the NCAA ment.

After four seasons as an assistant for the men's program at VMI (1994-98), he moved back to his alma mater as a men's assistant from 1998-2002. He was named interim women's head coach on Dec. 6, 2002 before taking over those duties on a full-time basis on March 21, 2003.

Brooks and his wife the former Chrissy Stewart have four children: Kendyl, Chloe, Gabby and Nicholas.
