THE HOKIES

Virginia Tech fell to on the road to Pittsburgh 72-64 the last time out. Regan Magarity led the Hokies with 18 points, six rebounds. Chanette Hicks tallied 15 points, six rebounds and six assists. Samantha Hill chipped in 14 points, six rebounds and Sidney Cook added 10 points.

The Hokies closed out opening quarter with an 11-0 run to take a 16-5 lead after holding the Panthers to 1-of-13 from the field in the first. Tech maintained its lead in the second and was still up by 11 after three minutes, but Pitt cut it down to six. The Hokies went back on top by nine (26-17), but Pitt scored the final baskets of the half to cut it to a five-point game at the break. Panthers came out firing in the third, connecting on three consecutive long-range shots to go up 30-26. The Hokies tied it up at 30-30, but Pitt reclaimed the advantage as Tech trailed 40-35 heading into the final 10 minutes. Pitt went up by nine, but Tech answered with a 7-0 run to cut it to 44-42. The Hokies kept the momentum going, taking a 49-47 lead midway through the frame. Pitt responded with a 12-2 run to go up 59-51, before a Tech 3-point play cut it back down to five heading into the final minute. Tech kept scoring, but the Panthers connected on 13-of-14 from the line as the Hokies got no closer than four the rest of the way.

Hicks leads the Hokies, averaging 16.0 points, 5.1 assists and 3.8 steals per game. Cook is posting 13.8 ppg and 8.3 rpg. Magarity is averaging 13.2 ppg and 9.5 rebounds per game while Hill is adding 10.0 ppg.

THE CAVALIERS

Virginia upset No. 4 Florida State, 60-51, on Thursday. Dominique Toussaint dropped in 14 points to lead the Cavaliers. J'Kyra Brown added 10 points and Lisa Jablonowski grabbed eight rebounds.

Virginia held the lead after the opening quarter, getting out on top of the Seminoles 16-11. The teams kept it close in the second, but FSU tied it up 26-26 at the break. Florida State came out firing in the third, outscoring UVA 20-15 to take the 46-41 lead heading into the final 10 minutes. The Seminoles pushed their lead to seven early in the frame, but the Cavaliers reclaimed the lead five minute later. A FSU 3-pointer with 2:59 to go was the last basket for the Noles as UVA closed out the game on a 10-0 run.

Lauren Moses leads the Cavaliers with 10.4 points per game while pulling down 5.8 rebounds per game. Toussaint is adding 10.0 ppg and handing out 2.6 apg. Breyana Mason is chipping in 9.8 ppg and 2.9 apg. Jocelyn Willoughby is tallying a team-high 6.3 rpg.

THE SERIES

The series against UVA marks one of the oldest in program history with the two teams meeting every season except 1991-92 since 1976. UVA holds the series record at 46-10, and won the earlier meeting this season in Charlottesville. Magarity led the Hokies with eight points and 10 rebounds. Willoughby had 18 points and five boards while Mason added 17 points, six boards for UVA.

Tech won the game the last time the two teams squared off in Blacksburg, 60-55 on Feb. 28, 2016. Hicks came off the bench to lead the Hokies with 19 points, eight rebounds. Former Tech player Tajah Campbell added 14 points. Mason had 10 points for UVA and Moses grabbed 12 boards.

This game is part of the Virginia 529 Commonwealth Clash in which the Hokies currently lead 5-3-5.

Up Next: Virginia Tech remains at Cassell Coliseum to host Miami on Thursday, Feb. 23. Game time is set for 7 p.m.

NOTEWORTHY

LENDING A HAND

Chanette Hicks has set the Virginia Tech assists record for a sophomore season. She breaks the Lisa Witherspoon's sophomore tally of 124 set 1996-97. Hicks set the freshman class record last year finishing with 134.

BLOCK PARTY

Regan Magarity has tallied 23 blocks this season versus ACC opponents. The mark ties the program single-season record against ACC foes set by Nare Diawara, 2006-07.

STEALING THE SEASON

With her first steal of the game against Louisville, **Chanette Hicks** set a new single-season record. The Tech sophomore set the record last year with 91 as a freshman. She tallied seven in the game versus the Cardinals. Hicks also has the steals mark for a sophomore campaign, breaking Sandy Berry's 70 from 1978-79.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Sidney Cook and **Regan Magarity** both rank in the NCAA in double-doubles on the season. Magarity comes in at 25th with 12 total, averaging 13.2 points and 9.5 rebounds per game. Cook ranks 37th with 10 total, averaging 13.8 points and 8.3 rebounds per game.

SHOOTING FROM THE FIELD

Currently the Hokies have three players ranked in the nation in field goal percentage: **Regan Magarity** (61st, .516), **Sidney Cook** (132nd, .458) and **Chanette Hicks** (134th, .456). The trio is averaging over half the Hokies points per game at a combined 42.4 ppg.

PICKING POCKETS

Chanette Hicks ranks fourth in the NCAA in total steals and in steals per game. She leads the ACC in both categories.

HOKIES FOR THREE!

Out of 10 Tech players who have appeared for the Hokies this season, eight of them have connected on baskets from outside the arc. **Vanessa Panousis** leads the group with 50 treys. **Kendyl Brooks** has 42 and **Sami Hill** has 37.

CONNECTING FROM LONG RANGE

The Hokies' 10 3-pointers made at Georgia Tech marks the most team field goals from outside the arc in ACC competition in program history. The former tally was nine set five times previously.

FAVORABLE FRAME

Virginia Tech's 29 points in the second quarter against the Yellow Jackets is the most scored by the Hokies in a quarter in ACC play. It also ties three other games overall.

MOVING UP

Two Hokies moved up on career lists against Notre Dame. **Chanette Hicks** moved into the top-5 on the Tech career steals list while **Vanessa Panousis** moved into the top-3 of career starts.

I'LL KEEP THIS

Virginia Tech held Syracuse to just six steals in the game against the Orange despite SU averaging 12.6 steals per game. On the flip side, the Hokies tallied eight, including six by **Chanette Hicks**.

STRAIGHT DOUBLES

Regan Magarity recorded seven consecutive double-doubles, breaking the program record of six set twice previously: Uju Ugoka hit it in 2013 while Karen Garbis held the original record with six in 1978.

HOT START: ACC EDITION

Virginia Tech got off to a 3-1 start in league play. It marks the best conference start through the first four games in program history. Previous bests were 2-2 in 2015-16, 2011-12, and 2004-05.

PROTECTING THE BALL

The Hokies gave up just six turnovers in the win over Wake Forest on Jan. 16, tying the fewest amount of team turnovers in a game. Tech also had six at Georgia Tech in 2015 and at Notre Dame in 2002. On the season, the Hokies are one of the best teams in the NCAA at protecting the ball, ranking in the top-10 in turnovers per game and fewest total turnovers.

SOPH STEALS

Chanette Hicks has already set the sophomore class steals record this season when she scooped one up at Miami. She broke the 38-year-old record of 70 set by Sandy Berry in 1978-79. Hicks already holds the freshman class record, single-season record, single-season ACC record and has broken in to the career top-10 list.

HOT START

The Hokies opened the season 15-0, marking the program's second best start. The best start was an 18-0 clip in 1998-99.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Three Hokies recorded double-doubles in the game against North Carolina. **Regan Magarity** had 24 points, 17 rebounds; **Sidney Cook** tallied 16 points, 13 rebounds; while **Chanette Hicks** had 10 points, 10 assists. It is just the third time in program history the feat has been achieved. The last time three Tech players had double-doubles in a game was 2010 with Monet Tellier (14 pts, 10 rebs), Alyssa Fenyn (10 pts, 10 rebs) and Nikki Davis (16 pts, 12 rebs) against William & Mary.

MAGARITY'S MARK

Regan Magarity tallied 24 points and 17 rebounds against North Carolina, marking the 20th time in program history that a player has eclipsed 20+/15+. It is also just the second time it has happend versus an ACC opponent. Kerri Gardin had 22 points, 16 rebounds versus FSU in 2005.

FIERY FIRST HALF

Virginia Tech scored 52 points in the first half against Delaware State, marking the most points scored in the opening 20 minutes since the Hokies dropped in 53 versus High Point in 2007.

NON-CONFERENCE DOMINANCE

The Hokies went undefeated in the non-conference for just the fourth time in program history. The other seasons Tech went undefeated in the non-conference were 2005-06, 2003-04 and 1998-99.

RECORD WORTHY

With 13 assists at Auburn **Chanette Hicks** tied the Tech single-game assist record. Lisa Witherspoon hit the mark twice in 1999 while Lisa Leftwich set the record in 1992.

BACK-TO-BACK

With 92 points scored against Auburn, it is just third time in program history the Hokies have scored 90+ in back-to-back games. Tech tallied 98 vs. BGSU in the previous game.

NOTEWORTHY (CONT.)**SUPER SIX**

Six Hokies hit double-digits against Bowling Green on Dec. 11. It was the first time six players had more than 10 points in a game since Howard on Nov. 9, 2013.

ALL THE POINTS

The 98 points the Hokies scored against Bowling Green marked the most by the program since dropping in 103 against High Point to open the 2007-08 season.

QUALITY QUINTET

Five players scored in double-digits for the Hokies against Gardner-Webb, marking the first time in two seasons (Wake Forest, Jan. 23, 2015) that five players have scored 10+ in the same game.

WE'RE BACK

Virginia Tech cracked into the Top-25 for the first time in over a decade on Dec. 5. The last time the Hokies were ranked was Jan. 23, 2006 at 25th.

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

The Hokies defeated Nebraska on Dec. 1, to pick up a win in the 2016 ACC/BigTen Challenge. Tech helped the ACC retain the crown and won their second straight challenge contest, marking the first time in program history the Hokies have won back-to-back games in the challenge.

ON THE LIST

The Hokies win over #17/16 Tennessee was not only a noteworthy win for the program, but for head coach **Kenny Brooks** as well, marking the third best win over a ranked opponent:

- #11 Old Dominion 76-63 (2007-08, JMU)
- #14 Virginia 75-63 (2009-10, JMU)
- #17 Tennessee 67-63 (2016-17, VT)**
- #18 Gonzaga 72-63 (2014 NAAs, JMU)
- #23 UCLA 91-87 (2014-15, JMU)

HONORED

Chanette Hicks was named the espnW National Player of the Week as well as ACC co-Player of the Week after leading the Hokies to wins over College of Charleston and #17/16 Tennessee. Hicks averaged 23.0 ppg, connecting on 48.4 percent from the field. She also tallied 14 steals, including eight against the Lady Vols.

PANOUSIS FOR THREE!

Senior **Vanessa Panousis** became the Virginia Tech all-time career leader in 3-pointers made on Nov. 16 against Presbyterian with her long distance shot made with 6:05 to go in the game. She moved into the top spot, eclipsing Carrie Mason who tallied 200 treys in 2002-06.

OFF TO A GOOD START

The Hokies opened the **Kenny Brooks** coaching era with a 71-52 win over UNC Asheville on Nov. 11.

STARTING SUCCESS

Virginia Tech improved to a season opening record of 40-10 all-time including a 21-4 tally at home.

RETURNING FOR 16-17

The Hokies return three starters from last season's team that finished with an 18-14 overall record and helped the program to its first postseason appearance in nine years as Tech received an at-large bid to the WNIT. Last year also marked the first winning season for the Hokies since 2006-07.

WELCOME TO BLACKSBURG

Kenny Brooks takes the helm of the Virginia Tech women's basketball team this season. Brooks compiled a 337-122 (.756) record during 14 seasons at James Madison, guiding the Dukes to 11 consecutive postseason appearances including six NCAA bids and five trips to the WNIT. Over 11 seasons at JMU, Brooks' squads never won fewer than 24 games, averaging 26.3 wins per year over that span.

MEMBER OF THE CLUB

Senior **Vanessa Panousis** hit the 1,000 point mark last year becoming the 24th member of the 1,000-point club and just the ninth player to do so as a junior. In addition, Panousis set the Virginia Tech career record for 3-pointers made in ACC games.

FANTASTIC FRESHMAN

Sophomore **Chanette Hicks** had a big freshman season, setting four new program records. Hicks set the new marks for single-season steals overall, steals in an ACC season, freshman class steals and freshman class assists. Hicks set the new single-season steals record and the assist record during the opening round WNIT game versus Elon. She broke the previous record that was set in 1998-99 by Lisa Witherspoon with 86. The freshman class assist record was set by Hicks' teammate Vanessa Panousis with 121 in 2013-14. She broke the ACC season record and freshman class steals records during conference play.

SID THE KID

Senior **Sidney Cook** led the Hokies in scoring and rebounds last season. She averaged 10.7 points per game and upped her average to 11.7 in ACC games. Cook posted 5.8 rebounds per game and led the Hokies in scoring in a 11 games and rebound in 10.

MILESTONE MOMENTS

The Hokies had several program milestones last season, including a 57-43 win over then-No. 8 Tennessee, marking Tech's first win over a top-10 team since Tech knocked off then-No. 8 Maryland in 2012. It was also the program's first win over the Lady Vols and snapped UT's 44-game home win streak. The win over Tennessee followed Tech's 64-59 victory over Penn State in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, marking the first time since 2003-04 that the Hokies picked up back-to-back wins over non-conference Power 5 opponents.

NEW KIDS IN TOWN

Virginia Tech added six players to the roster this season with juniors **Diandra DaRosa** and **Erin Garner**, sophomore **Michelle Berry** and freshmen **Kendyl Brooks** and **Kaela Kinder**.

KENNY BROOKS

Head Coach • First Season
James Madison, 1992

Kenny Brooks was named the seventh head women's basketball coach at Virginia Tech on March 28, 2016.

Brooks joined the Hokies after an impressive 14-season stint as head coach at James Madison University where he compiled a record of 337-122 (.756), making him the winningest coach in that school's history. Brooks guided the Dukes to 11 consecutive postseason appearances, including six NCAA bids and five trips to the WNIT. Under his direction in 2015-16, JMU compiled a 27-6 record, including a 17-1 mark in conference play, as the Dukes made a third straight trip to the NCAA tournament.

Over 11 seasons at JMU, Brooks' squads never won fewer than 24 games, averaging 26.3 wins per year over that span. The Dukes won three consecutive (2014, 2015, 2016) Colonial Athletic Association championships under Brooks' tutelage and captured five conference titles over a seven season span. He was named CAA Coach of the Year for a fourth time in 2015-16, while his student-athletes also garnered CAA Player and Rookie of the Year honors.

Brooks registered winning campaigns in 13 of his 14 seasons in Harrisonburg, ascending to No. 23 in the AP Top 25 and No. 21 in the USA Today Coaches Poll in 2014-15 as his squad tied a school record with 29 victories. In 2013-14, he led the Dukes to their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1991 when his 11th-seeded Dukes knocked off sixth-seeded Gonzaga 72-63 in the first round. In 2007, the Dukes earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, marking only the second time a CAA team had received an at-large berth.

Under Brooks, James Madison tallied six CAA Players of the Year, three Rookies of the Year and two Defensive Players of the Year. The Dukes also earned 31 All-CAA selections, 11 Defensive team and 10 All-Rookie team selections during his tenure.

The Waynesboro, Virginia, native, has coached two WNBA Draft picks, including first-round pick Tamera Young and most recently (April 2015) third-round selection Lauren Okafor, in addition to three other players who have signed professional contracts.

A 1992 graduate of James Madison, he played three seasons under legendary coach Lefty Driesell and made two NIT appearances while earning a degree in business management. He began his coaching career as a part-time assistant for the 1993-94 JMU men's squad that won the CAA Tournament and advanced to the NCAA tournament.

After four seasons as an assistant for the men's program at VMI (1994-98), he moved back to his alma mater as a men's assistant from 1998-2002. He was named interim women's head coach on Dec. 6, 2002 before taking over those duties on a full-time basis on March 21, 2003.

Brooks and his wife the former Chrissy Stewart have four children: Kendyl, Chloe, Gabby and Nicholas.
